3 <u>15A NCAC 07J .1402</u> APPLICATION PROCESSING

- 4 (a) On receipt of a CAMA major development and/or dredge and fill permit application that complies with the form
- 5 and includes the content required in 15A NCAC 07J.1400 and .1401, the Department shall send a notification to the
- 6 <u>applicant acknowledging receipt of a complete application and begin processing the application.</u>
- 7 (b) If the Division of Coastal Management finds that additional information is necessary to complete its investigation
- 8 of the proposed development to determine whether a permit application shall be approved or denied, the Division shall
- 9 request that additional information from the applicant.
- 10 (c) If the Division of Coastal Management finds an application is incomplete or contains inaccurate information after
- 11 processing has begun, the Division shall notify the applicant of the deficiency or inaccuracy and request the applicant
- 12 provide the required information.
- 13 (d) In order to determine the environmental impact of the proposed project, the Department shall prepare a field report
- 14 on each major development and/or dredge and fill permit application accepted for processing. Such report shall be
- 15 prepared after an on-site investigation is completed. The report shall include project location, environmental setting,
- 16 project description and probable environmental impact.
