(b) All floating structures shall be in conformance with local regulations for on-shore sewage treatment. 7 (c) A boat shall be deemed a floating structure when its means of propulsion has been removed or rendered inoperative 8 9 and it contains at least 200 square feet of living space area. 10 (d) A floating upweller system is a structure used in mariculture for the purpose of growing shellfish.
