Question 44 and Question 64 Table: Please note that Waste Industries picks up our trash and recyclables the same time they pick up Burgaw's. Therefore, their trash and recycables are mixed together so we had to divided it based on households. Burgaw (which has 1225 households) have trash pickup once a week and half the town gets their reycables picked up that week while the other half gets their recycables picked up the next week. We have weekly recycling in St. Helena. The amount recieved was \$322.39 (estimated) in waste tax refund from N. C. We use our general fund money (property tax, franchaise tax, etc.) to pay Waste Industries for trash and recycling pick-up. (note from Villiage of St Helena Staff on 6-30-2021 -DH)

Question 63- Unusual Situation with the Arrangement the town has with GFL: The following came out of an email between myself and Judith at St. Helena:

"On question 63, we had a contract years ago with OSC who was brought out by Waste Industries. Waste Industries was brought out by GFL. GFL also brought out the Pink Ladies, Waste Management, and 4 other companies to make them the only big waste/ recycling company in the 5 county area that we know of. The contract has never been renewed. We have tried to find another company because their service and phone calls don't get answered. Basically, it is an open-ending contract. We have to give 60 days notice if we want to end the contract and they have to give us 60 days notice if they want to drop us."
