EDUCATION

2138 students visited reserves to learn about estuaries through hands on experiences

Held **3** professional development workshops, enhancing estuarine literacy for **36** educators across N.C.

TRAINING

Served communities throughout coastal N.C. by offering 10 workshops on Clean Marinas, climate change adaptation and resilience, low impact development, barrier island development, & coastal management resources from NOAA's Digital Coast.

Reached 300 professionals, including land use planners, marina operators and owners, real estate agents, local government staff, state and federal agency staff, & non-profit organizations for 1,920 contact hours

RESEARCH

Collected over **264,000** water quality, meteorological & nutrient measurements as part of the System-Wide Monitoring Program

Collaborated with **7** partner organizations to conduct & support **36** active research projects at Reserve sites up and down the coast

STEWARDSHIP

334 volunteers contributed 2,000+
hours, or \$46,800+ in value, to
stewardship initiatives such as
marine debris cleanups, trail
maintenance, shorebird nesting
protection, & bird and turtle surveys

Nearly **70** citizen scientists collected data at Reserve sites to protect marine birds, shorebird nesting, terrapin populations & remove marine debris
