## **Division of Water Infrastructure Staff Report**

Approximately 290 applications were received as part of the September 2017 funding round. The types of applications received are for:

- Construction projects (wastewater, drinking water or stormwater/stream restoration)
- CDBG-I projects
- Asset Inventory and Assessment grants (AIA)
- Merger/Regionalization Feasibility grants (MRF)

Using the streamlined process, Division staff is determining the possible source(s) of funding for which an applicant/project is eligible. If an applicant is eligible to receive grant funds, the affordability criteria will be applied to determine the percentage of the project cost that could be offered as a grant.

If an applicant/project may be considered for funding from more than one source of funds, the Division will formulate a strategy for project funding.

This is the last round of Connect NC bond fund applications.

The Authority will make funding decisions at its February 18, 2017 meeting.
