


The Level 2 Multi-Unit Dwellings Request for Proposal (RFP) was released May 2, 2022

Applications open: June 13, 2022 12:00 AM ET

Applications accepted and approved on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are exhausted.







This is a reimbursement program.

Applicants are limited to \$25,000 in approved rebate vouchers at any time.

Rebate vouchers expire one year from the date an agreement is fully executed.

Eligible applicants include:

 Property owners, management companies or home owner's association of Multi-Unit Dwellings in North Carolina such as apartment complexes, condominiums, etc. This excludes individually owned townhouses, row houses and mobile homes.

Specific details can be found in the <u>Level 2 MUD</u> RFP.



Eligible locations include:

• Multi-unit dwellings with 10 or more units such as apartment complexes, condominiums, etc.

Ineligible locations include:

- Locations at an individual single-family residences.
- Locations at individually owned townhouses, row houses and mobile homes.
- Locations for employee or fleet-only charging.



Level 2 Multi-Unit Dwellings Rebate Amounts

| Project Type | Accessible to General Public | Maximum Rebate per Charging Port | Or (whichever is less) | Maximum % of Total Project Costs |
|---------------------|---------------------------------|--|------------------------|--|
| Multi-Unit Dwelling | Yes | \$4,000 | or | 80% |
| Multi-Unit Dwelling | No | \$3,000 | or | 60% |



Project Requirements:

- Minimum of 2 ports per project.
- The installed Level 2 charging station(s) must connect to a network by wired Ethernet, Wi-Fi, or cellular connection.
- Chargers must be maintained and operated for a minimum of five years from the date of project completion.

Additional requirements in the RFP.



Site Requirements:

- Publicly accessible sites must be available for use by the public for an annual average of 12 hours per day without access restrictions.
- If the property/site is not owned by the applicant, the rebate applicant must provide a signed letter from the landowner or HOA indicating approval of the project.
- Projects must include at least one designated and clearly marked EV parking space per port.

Additional requirements in the RFP.



Accessibility:

- Charging stations must make every effort to be ADA compliant and follow all applicable laws, ordinances, regulations and standards. (www.afdc.energy.gov/uploads/publication/WPCC complyingwithAD Arequirements 1114.pdf).

Eligible Expenditures:

- Commercial grade Level 2 charging station infrastructure
- Conduit, cable/wiring, electrical service box disconnect addition
- Concrete or asphalt replacement
- Paint striping and stenciling of the station parking spaces
- Signage
- Bollards
- Permit costs
- Labor for installation (electrical and trenching)
- Shipping of equipment
- Networking charges (maximum of five years, if paid in advance prior to claim reimbursement) – networked chargers only
- EVSE maintenance contracts (maximum of five years, if paid in advance prior to claim reimbursement)

How to Submit an Application

NCDEQ will only accept applications submitted through the NCDAQ Grant Management System (GMS) website, at https://www.ebs.nc.gov/irj/portal.

Prior to using the GMS, applicants must obtain an NCID and then complete and submit the online Enterprise Business Services
External Request Application.

Applicants must also complete and email the State of North Carolina Substitute W-9 Form to daq.NC_VWGrants@ncdenr.gov to get registered in the system.



- To request access to the DAQ Grants Management System, you will need an NCID to complete the access request form.

Acceptable NCID formats

- NCIDs must use the following format or your request for access will be denied.
 - First name or initial
 - Middle initial (optional)
 - Last name
 - Number (if name is already in use)
 - Example for Wile E. Coyote options for his NCID are:
 - Wileecoyote
 - Wilecoyote
 - Wilecoyote2
 - wcoyote

NCIDs must not be a company or organization name.



IMPORTANT NCID INFORMATION


- If you already have an individual or government NCID there is no need to create a new NCID.
- If you have any other EBS/SAP system account (Powell Bill, Governor Highway Safety Program (GHSP), Public Transportation Division (PTD), DPI, etc.) you will still need a NCID. There is a space on the access application for to put your current EBS/SAP account information.
- Once you have completed requesting a NCID, you will receive an email from New NCID User Registration nc.gov.

You MUST click the link in the email and follow the instructions to complete the registration of your NCID before submitting the

Enterprise Business Services External Request Application.










NCID

- NCIDs must be in the following format, or your request will be denied.
- Frist name, middle initial (optional), last name.
 - Example: John B Smith's NCID could be johnbsmith
- Additionally, a number can be added if the NCID is already used by someone else.
 - Example: John B Smith's NCID could be johnbsmith12
- Do not use a company or organization name as your NCID. It will be returned.











Your new NCID account has been created. Please click on the continue button to complete the security questions and answers to activate your account. You will be redirected to the NCID login page (https://ncidsspr.nc.gov).


- 1. You will need to login with your new NCID account name and password
- 2. Select 5 different security questions and answers
- 3. Click on the "Save Answers" button to save your security questions and answers
- 4. You will be able to review the questions selected. You can change them or select "No Change"
- 5. At this point your account is active and you are logged out of NCID.













DAQ Grant Management System (GMS)

You must read and follow all the directions on the next slides to request access to the DAQ Grants Management System and then be approved before you can log into the system!

Approved means you received a "Welcome to the DAQ Enterprise Business System Portal" email.

Requesting DAQ Grants Management System Access

Once all required forms are received to process GMS access requests, it could take a week or longer to complete!

Please do not wait until the week before the application opens to request access. At that point there will be no guarantee you will have access when the application opens.

THIRD PARTY ACCESS AUTHORIZATION FORMS

In cases where an applicant has a third-party submitting applications on their behalf, the following procedures must be followed:

- The applicant must provide in writing (email is sufficient) that they
 are authorizing the third-party to submit applications and other
 information on their behalf.
- The third-party will need to obtain their own NCID and submit an Access Authorization Request Application with the applicant's organization address information and the third-party's phone number and email address. Enter Third Party Contractor in the Comments field.

- Budget information should be as accurate as possible
- DEQ reserves the right to partially fund awarded projects
- We will not accept paper, scanned, emailed, or faxed applications.
- Do not sign any agreements with vendors or start work until your agreement is fully executed with NC DEQ
- APPLICATION AWARD IS NOT A FULLY EXECUTED AGREEMENT



Reporting Requirements

Quarterly Reporting Requirement

 Quarterly reports on the status of the project are to be uploaded to the Grants Management System until the final project report is submitted.

Annual Charging Station Utilization Reporting Requirements

 Annual EVSE usage data is given to NCDEQ for the previous 12 months on January 30th of each consecutive year for a five-year period after installation of the charging station(s).

Final Project Report

 A final project report with a narrative summary of the project and photographic evidence of installation.



DAQ Site Visits

 DAQ Staff will perform site visits at all stations to verify installation and operation of the charging station prior to approval of any reimbursement claim.

DAQ staff must be granted access to the charging site.
