World Cat Greenville has applied to the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality for approval to construct and operate a boat manufacturing facility at:

World Cat Greenville's application was reviewed by the Division of Air Quality, Raleigh Central Office to determine compliance with the requirements of the North Carolina Environment Management Commission air pollution regulations. The results of that review led to the preliminary determination that the project could be approved and the Division of Air Quality permit could be issued if certain permit conditions are met.

This notice serves as a Notice of Public Hearing and Opportunity for Public Comment for this proposal. The Public hearing will be held at the Pitt County Community College, Williams Auditorium at 6 p.m. on August 25, 2022, located at 2105 Warren Dr, Winterville, NC 28590.
