## Landfill proposed near your community

Your community is near a proposed landfill Duke Energy wants to construct and operate at its Sutton Energy Complex Facility in Wilmington.

Duke Energy has proposed constructing the fully-lined landfill (see map) to dispose of coal ash currently contained in unlined basins on the utility's property.

A state-issued solid waste permit will be required to construct and operate the industrial landfill.

The draft permit includes safeguards to protect public health and the environment. For example, the draft permit requires Duke Energy to build the landfill with a system for collecting and treating wastewater. The N.C. Department of Environmental Quality will consult with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and review information gathered about the proposed landfill before making a final agency decision on the permit.
