1 15A NCAC 07M .0602 is proposed for amendment as follows: 2 3 15A NCAC 07M .0602 DEFINITIONS 4 (a) A boat is a vessel or watercraft of any type or size specifically designed to be self-propelled, whether by engine, 5 sail, oar, or paddle or other means, which is used to travel from place to place by water. 6 (b) A "floating structure" is any structure, not a boat, supported by a means of flotation, designed to be used without 7 a permanent foundation, which is used or intended for human habitation or commerce. A structure will be considered 8 a floating structure when it is inhabited or used for commercial purposes for more than thirty days in any one location. 9 A boat may be deemed a floating structure when its means of propulsion has been removed or rendered inoperative 10 and it contains at least 200 square feet of living space area. 11 (c) A floating upweller system is a structure used in mariculture for the purpose of growing shellfish.
