Dear Mr. McGaughy:

Over the last month, at the request of the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), extensive sampling has been performed at the Chemours' Fayetteville Works facility. Based on these results, Chemours has agreed to capture additional industrial process wastewater for offsite disposal from areas where per-and polyfluorinated compounds were detected. Based on these actions by Chemours to address the concerns expressed in DEQ's September 5, 2017 letter and the measures that Chemours has taken to comply with the Partial Consent Order dated September 8, 2017, DEQ has concluded that it is not necessary to suspend Chemours' NPDES permit as contemplated in the letter. DEQ will continue to monitor the performance of all required remedial measures by Chemours.
