SUBJECT: PFAS Recovery Fund Status Quarterly Report, September 2020

Session Law 2018-5 established the PFAS Recovery Fund, including Section 13.1(d) that provides funding for local government units to assist with planning and analyzing water lines to serve impacted areas. This quarterly report provides the status of grant funding under Section 13.1(d).

Effective June 30, 2020, S.L. 2020-79, Sec. 9 transferred and reallocated the entire \$2 million fund balance in the PFAS Recovery Fund as follows:

\$837,755	Compensatory Mitigation Fund	Dissolving conservation easement in Alamance County
\$200,000	Oil or Other Hazardous Substances Pollution Protection Fund	For use by DEQ to investigate and remediate petroleum product discharges in NC waters that are ineligible for other funding
\$100,000	MountainTrue	Recreational water quality testing
\$500,000	Town of Maysville	Remediation, modification, reconstruction, or replacement of a contaminated public water supply well
\$100,000	Town of Benson	Water and wastewater infrastructure project
\$100,000	Town of Angier	Water and wastewater infrastructure project
\$162,245	Town of Kenansville	Water and wastewater infrastructure project
