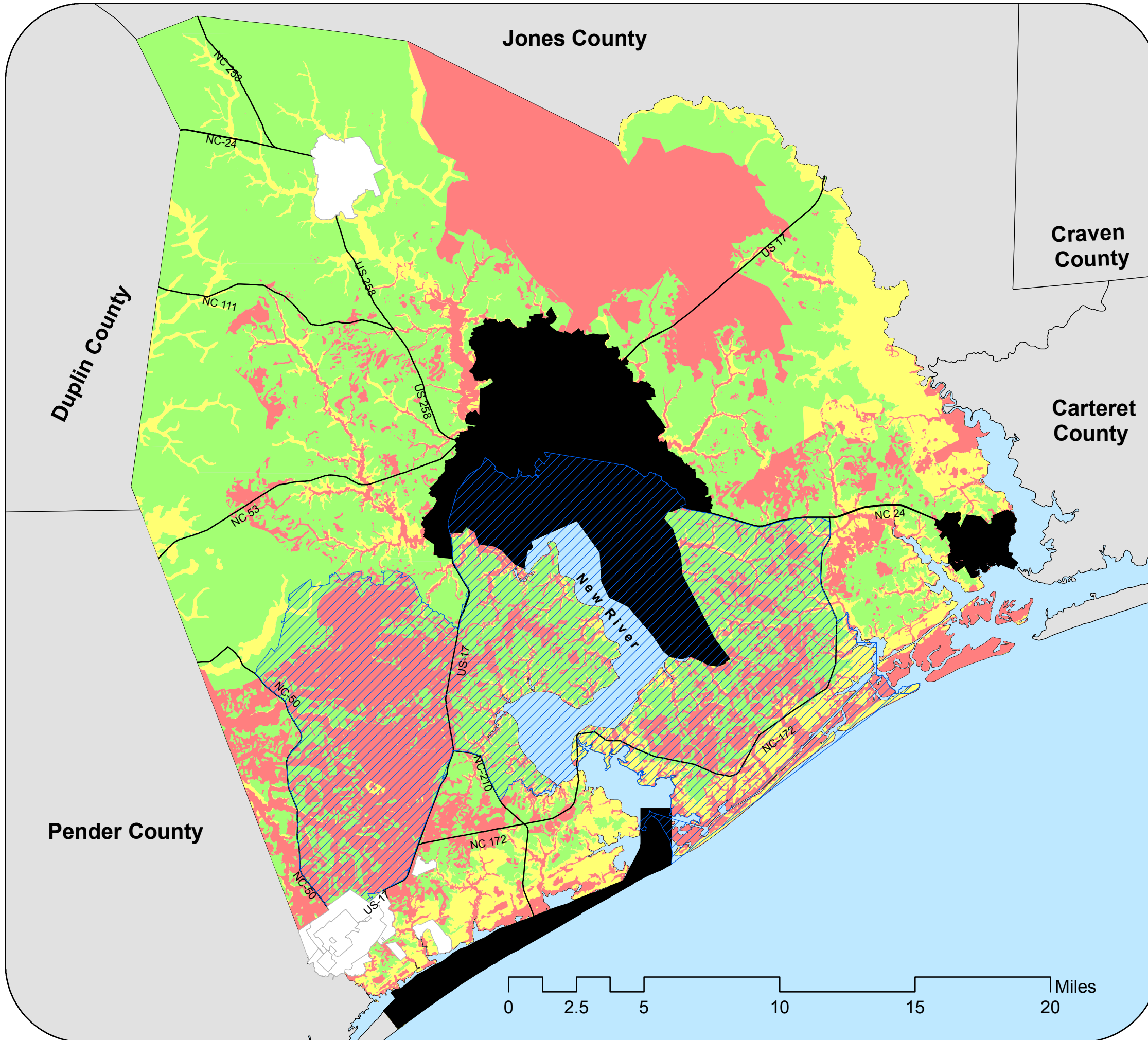

## Environmental Composite and Environmental Sensitivity

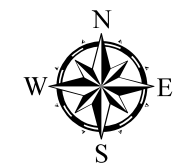

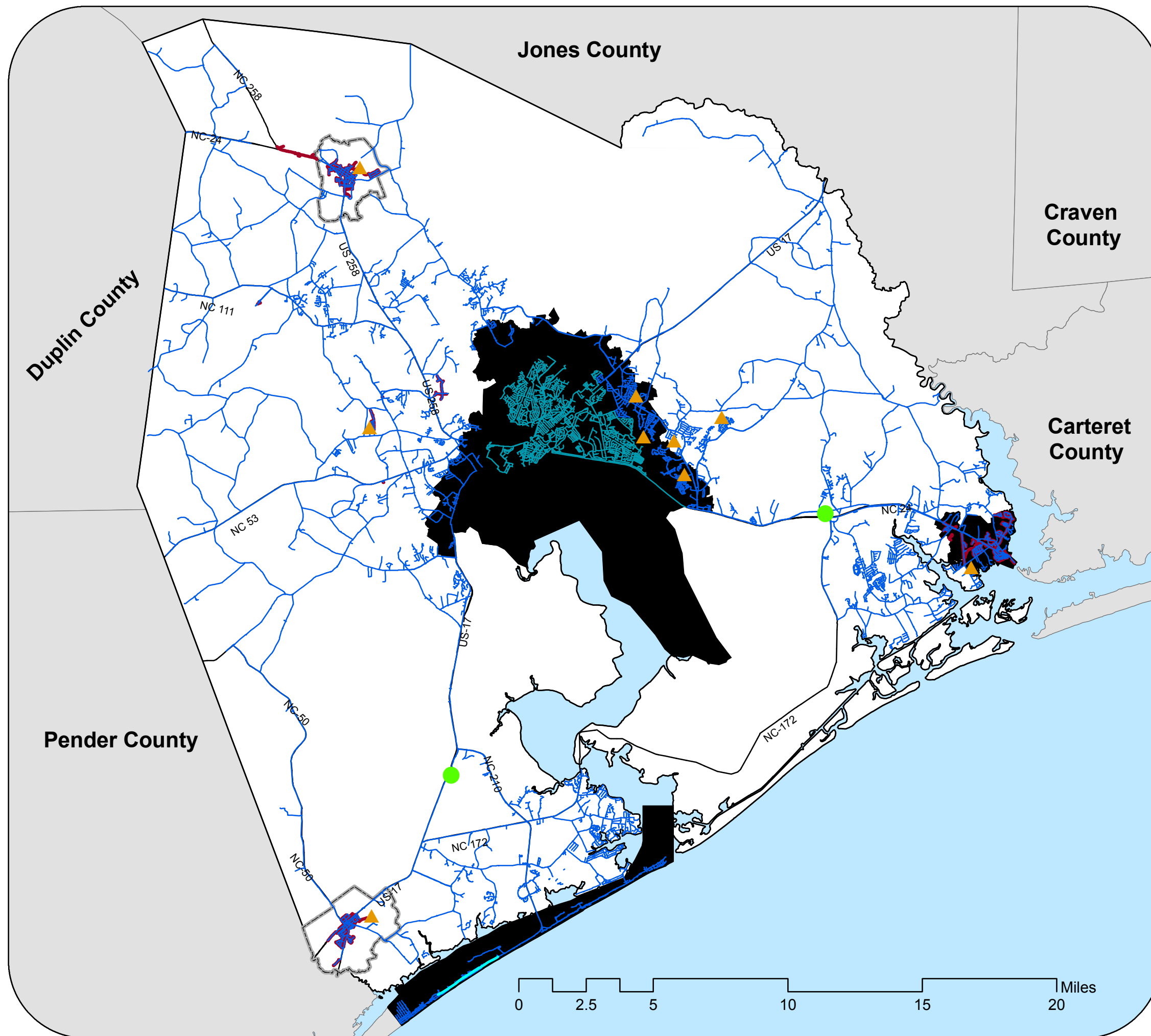

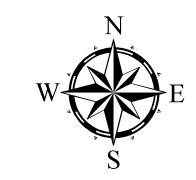

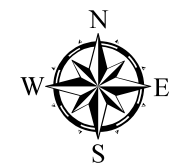

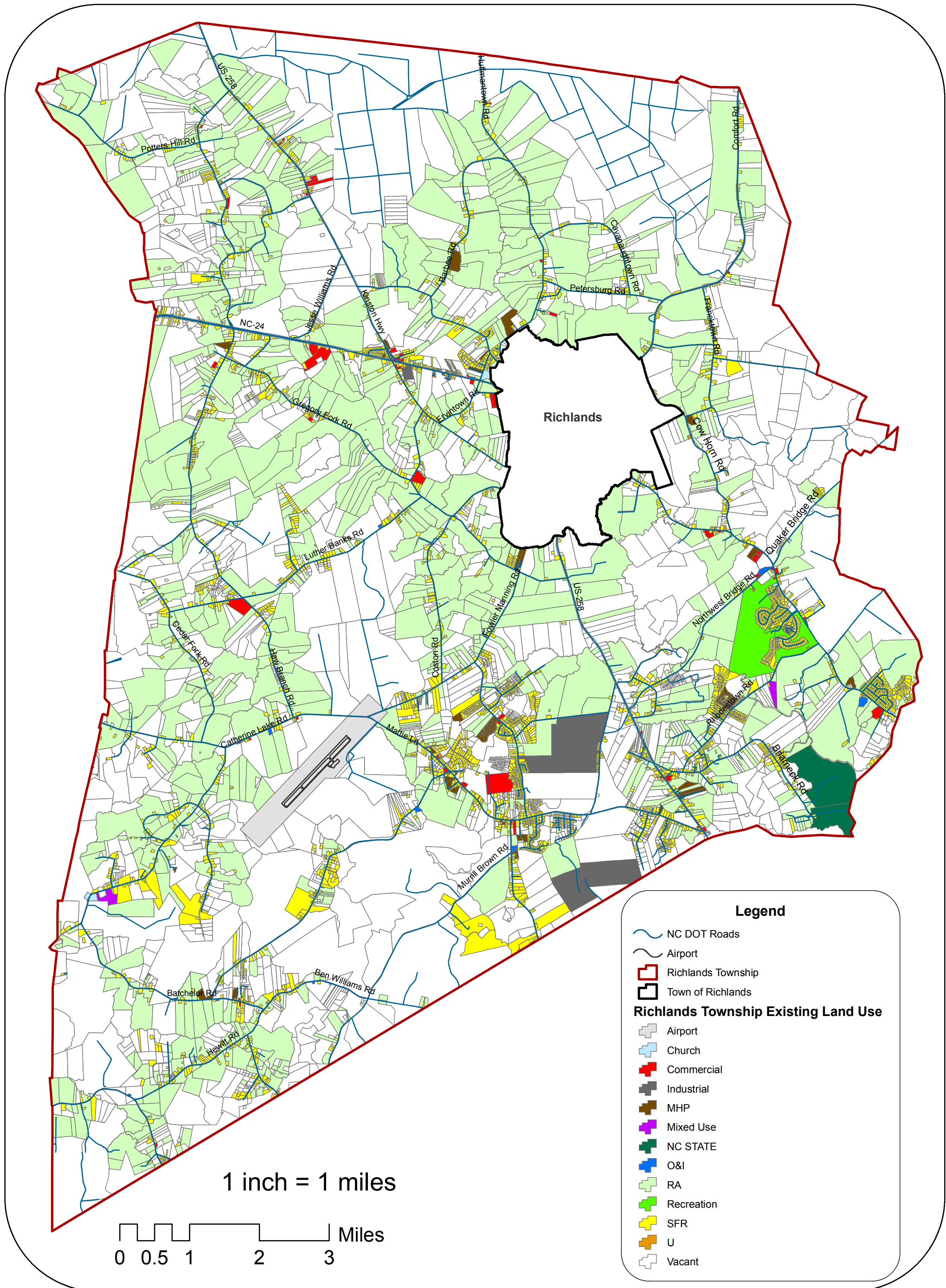

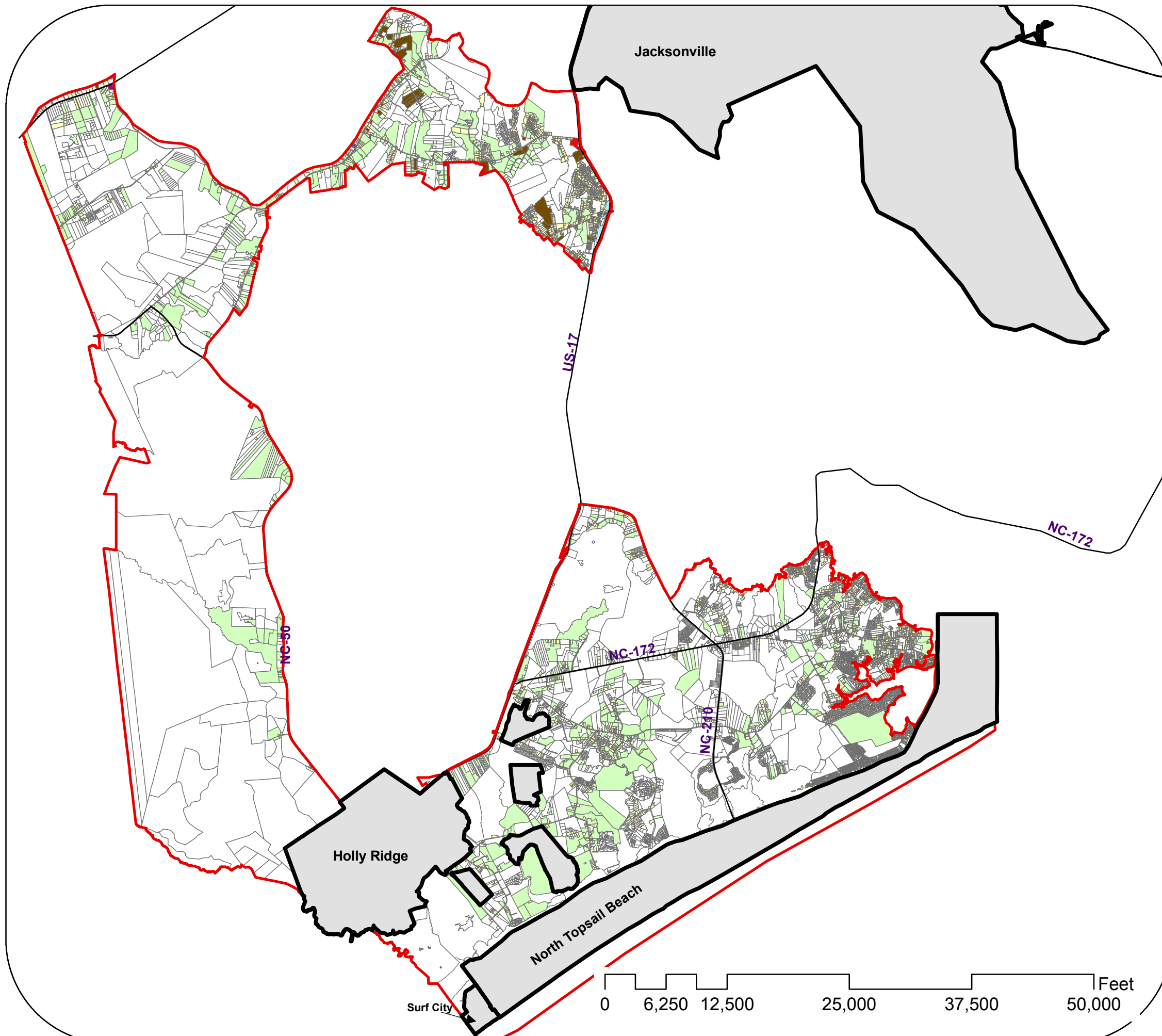
## Existing Land Use Richlands Township
