
Project Description: The proposed project will upgrade two pump stations (Junction and Bridge Street) to regain lost capacity and address reliability, operational and electric deficiencies that impact performance and have contributed to sanitary sewer overflows. The proposed work includes the following improvements: Rehabilitation of Junction and Bridge Street Pump Stations by replacing existing pumps and equipment as well as installing new direct access to the pumps, generator with ATS, flow monitors, air conditioning of VFDs, inline grinder, exterior vault, flush port, and separate electrical room.

The above named applicant will receive funding assistance from the State Revolving Fund program to construct the wastewater facilities described above. The North Carolina Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) has conducted a review of the project in accordance with the procedures (NCAC 15A Subchapter 1C) for conformance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act. The Division has determined that this project is below the minor construction activities threshold outlined in 15A NCAC 01C .0408; therefore, the project is exempt from inter-agency review, and the preparation of additional environmental documents is not required.

This determination shall become effective upon its distribution by the Division and will be available on the Division's website (<http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wi/fonsi-dmca-ce>). This determination can be revoked at any time adverse information is made available. The documentation to support this decision will be on file with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Water Infrastructure, and is available for public scrutiny upon request.
