Stormwater Program – Updates on the NCG01 Renewal



- Current NCG010000 permit expires March 31, 2024
 - NCG250000 (not subject to SPCA, but subject to CWA) expires May 31, 2024
- Plan to renew both on April 1, 2024
- With our focus and on-going efforts to introduce a combined electronic application process for E&SC approval and NCG01 coverage (PTP), we will be renewing the NCG01 permit without significant changes
- Some minor “corrections”
 - Remove exclusion for landfills under NCG120000 (oversight in current NCG01)
 - Clarify that a rain gauge or other rain-monitoring device shall be onsite, unless receive DEMLR Regional Office approval
 - Include reference to secondary containment requirements for above-ground petroleum storage per SPCC regulations
 - Annual fee requirement for continuation of previously permitted projects
- Seek input from a select group of stakeholders regarding current permit
- Draft the new permit in early 2024 for public comment period
- Received comments will be considered prior to final permit renewal on April 1, 2024



Stormwater Program – Updates on the NCG01 Renewal

- Current status of NCG01 PTP
 - Will soon begin conducting internal UAT to ensure successful system
 - Projected “go-live” likely after permit renewal
