Recommendations of the Sedimentation Education Committee

May 9, 2012

The Sedimentation Education Committee met on May 9, 2012. Land Quality staff anticipate sedimentation education funding to remain unchanged at \$135,000 for the 2012-2012 Fiscal Year.

The Erosion and Sedimentation Training Needs Assessment was presented and discussed. In response to the survey results, one-day rather than two-day workshops were proposed for the coming fiscal year.

The committee approved the following contract proposals:
