## Local Program Staffing

Ms. Coco presented an analysis of sample data collected from local programs regarding staffing levels and related it to workload. Several commission members thanked Ms. Coco for this overview.

## **NCDOT Report**

Ms. Coco stated that there were no Immediate Corrective Action (ICA) reports issued by the NCDOT and no trout buffer waivers issued to the Department by DEMLR during the previous quarter.

## **Commission Technical Committee Update**

Mr. Mark Taylor, the Chair of the Committee, shared that the committee continues to meet monthly. He gave an update on the progress made on the practice standards in the *Erosion and Sediment Control Planning and Design Manual* and stated that some standards were being reviewed multiple times. He has begun communicating with DEMLR staff on the progression of reviews and what constitutes final acceptance. Some practice standards have been prioritized based on feedback from DEMLR regional staff with others considered new or supplemental for consideration. Working groups have been reorganized. Mr. Taylor will continue to chair this committee after his term on the Commission expires.

## Land Quality Section Active Sediment Cases and Enforcement

Ms. Coco reported on the status of civil penalty assessments and judicial actions.

#### **Education Program Status Report**

Ms. Coppa provided an update on the Education Program covering activities from April through December of 2024. This included the Chavis Park Stream Clean on April 26, 2024. The Annual E&SC Workshop will be held in Raleigh on December 5, 2024. The annual Local Programs Workshop & Awards Banquet is scheduled to be held in April of 2025 in Chatham County. Ms. Coppa is soliciting speakers for the workshops or articles for the SEDIMENTS Newsletters.

#### Sediment Program Status Report

Ms. Coco reported on the Land Quality Section's statewide plan approvals, inspections, and enforcement activities. Numbers were available through the end of June.

Ms. Coco reported on the number of vacancies within the Land Quality Section.
