PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION has applied to the North Carolina Division of Water Quality for an Individual Section 401 Water Quality Certification pursuant to Environmental Management Commission rules in 15A NCAC 2H .0500. The activity for which this Permit is sought is temporary fill of 0.01 acres in surface waters (Town Fork Creek) to replace Bridge No. 14 and Bridge No. 44 on NC Hwy 8 in Stokes County near the town of Germanton.

The public is invited to comment in writing to the Division of Water Quality on the above-mentioned application. Comments shall be sent to the N.C.
