

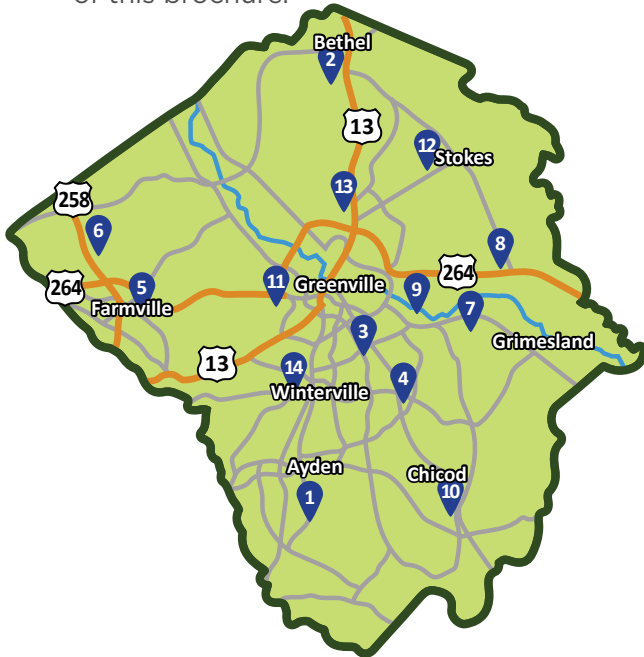
USING YOUR COUNTY'S CONVENIENCE DROP-OFF SITES
