Estuarine Flounder Dealer Permit

What Activities Require This Permit? Licensed fish dealers purchasing estuarine flounder from applicable gears and harvest areas selected on the permit. The mobile gear category includes all gears that are not a pound net with the management areas included a northern and southern region. The pound net category only includes pound net gears with the management areas split into a northern, central, and southern region.

What Is The Purpose of This Permit? In order to monitor the quota, the Division of Marine Fisheries needs to know which dealers are going to be participating in the fishery in order to determine who needs to submit daily quota monitoring reports.

Who Issues This Permit? N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries, License and Statistics Section.

How Much Will This Permit Cost? No cost.

How Long Is My Permit or License or Certificate Valid? Permits are valid for up to one fiscal year (July 1st to June 30th) and expire on June 30th.

Notes/Comments: A valid fish dealer license is required to obtain this permit. There are daily reporting requirements associated with this permit during the open estuarine flounder season for the respective gear(s) and harvest areas selected on the permit. Seasons and trip limits for each gear and harvest area for the fishery are established by proclamation.

Legal Authority/Statute Reference: General Statute 113-169.1, and 113-221.1, NC Fisheries Rules for Coastal Waters 15A NCAC 30.0501, 30.0502, 30.0503(e)(1) and 30.0506.
