Water Resources Development Project Grant Program
Fall 2014 Grant Awards

1. Ashe County, Town of Lansing, Big Horse Creek Greenway **\$120,000**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of Lansing for constructing a 3,000 foot greenway with amenities along Big Horse Creek.

2. Duplin County, Town of Wallace, Wallace Storm Drainage **\$25,000**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of Wallace for stormwater system upgrades along North Duplin Street.

3. Haywood County, Haywood Soil and Water, Ratcliff Cove Branch Restoration **\$33,577**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Haywood Soil and Water Conservation District for stabilizing 2,300 feet of eroding streambank along Ratcliff Cove Branch.

4. Haywood County, Haywood Soil and Water, Rogers Cove Creek Restoration **\$30,600**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Haywood Soil and Water Conservation District for stabilizing 1,600 feet of eroding streambank along Rogers Cove Creek.

5. Multiple Counties, Division of Soil and Water Conservation, Storm Debris Removal **\$250,000**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the NC Division of Soil and Water Conservation for the removal of storm debris from streams located in multiple eastern North Carolina counties.

6. New Hanover County, City of Wilmington, Wilmington Waterfront Planning **\$45,000**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the City of Wilmington for a feasibility study to examine potential shoreline improvements along a two mile reach of downtown river front.

7. Surry County, Surry Soil and Water, Ararat River Restoration **\$121,000**

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Surry Soil and Water Conservation District for a multi-phased Ararat River restoration project located in Mount Airy.

8. Transylvania County, Division of Forest Resources, Little River Restoration Master Plan \$45,000

This grant that will provide financial assistance to the NC Division of Forest Resources to develop a master plan that will identify future river, stream and wetland restoration efforts to improve the water quality and ecological function of the Little River and its tributaries within the DuPont State Recreational Forest.

9. Wilkes County, Town of North Wilkesboro, Memorial Park Stormwater Wetland \$96,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of North Wilkesboro for construction of a stormwater wetland to treat stormwater runoff flowing into the Yadkin River.

10. Yancey County, Yancey Soil and Water, Cane River Dam Removal and Stream Restoration \$200,000

This is a multi-agency project and the grant will provide financial assistance to the Yancey County Soil and Water Conservation District for removing the Cane River Dam and stabilizing 2,500 feet of downstream eroding streambank.
