

**Spring 2013 Grant Awards**  
**Water Resources Development Project Grant Program**  
**N.C. Division of Water Resources**

1. Forsyth County, Town of Kernersville, Kernersville Rainwater Harvesting Feasibility Study \$10,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of Kernersville for a stormwater collection and reuse system feasibility study.

2. Greene County, Town of Hookerton, Hookerton WWTP Contentnea Creek Stabilization Study \$24,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of Hookerton for an engineering/feasibility study for stabilizing 200 feet of eroding streambank along Contentnea Creek to protect an eroding dike at the wastewater treatment facility.

3. Harnett County, City of Dunn, City of Dunn Stormwater CIP Study \$15,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the City of Dunn for an engineering/feasibility study of four areas within the City that are prone to flooding.

4. Henderson County, Henderson County, French Broad River Greenway \$35,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to Henderson County for the design and construction of a 1,300 foot greenway trail along the French Broad River at Westfelt Park.

5. Martin County, Martin Soil and Water, Martin Agricultural Complex Water Management \$75,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Martin Soil and Water Conservation District for installing a rainwater harvesting system at the Bob Martin Agricultural Complex.

6. Mitchell County, Mitchell Soil and Water, Grassy Creek Restoration \$50,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Mitchell County Soil and Water Conservation District for stabilizing 2,000 feet of eroding streambank along Grassy Creek.

7. Orange County, Town of Hillsborough, Lake Ben Johnson Dredging \$50,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Town of Hillsborough for restoring reservoir capacity at Lake Ben Johnson by dredging 3,200 cubic yards of accumulated sediment.

8. Randolph County, City of Asheboro, Lake Lucas Peninsula Park \$65,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the City of Asheboro for acquiring 33 acres of lake front property and developing a low impact water based recreation facility.

9. Surry County, Surry Soil and Water, Big Creek Restoration Phase 2 \$166,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Surry County Soil and Water Conservation District for stabilizing 3,800 feet of eroding streambank along Big Creek.

10. Yancey County, Yancey Soil and Water, Cane River Dam Removal and Stream Restoration \$75,000

This grant will provide financial assistance to the Yancey County Soil and Water Conservation District for removing the Cane River Dam and stabilizing 2,500 feet of downstream eroding streambank.
