# Risk Category Assignments

- 9 High (unchanged)
  - Hazardous Waste Generator/Transporters (HWGT)
  - Hazardous Waste Treatment/Storage/ Disposal (TSD)
  - National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)
  - National Priority List Sites (NPL)
  - Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCB) Sites
  - Pollution Incidents (PIRF)
  - Superfund Sites (CERCLIS)
  - Tier II Sites
  - Underground Storage Tank Facilities (UST)



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## Risk Category Assignments

- 5 Moderate
  - Animal Operations Facilities (AO)
  - Non-Discharge Permits (NDP)
  - Old Landfill Sites / Pre-Regulatory Sites (UDS)
  - Soil Remediation Sites
  - Solid Waste Facilities



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## Risk Category Assignments

- 2 Low
  - Septage Disposal Sites
  - Underground Injection Control Permits (UIC)



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## PCS Categories to Consider

- Chemical/petroleum storage and processing
- Chemical/petroleum pipelines
- Above ground storage tanks
- Fertilizer/pesticide storage, distribution, handling, and mixing sites
