Project Description:

The proposed project will replace or rehabilitate sanitary sewer lines and manholes adjacent to Queen Street in downtown Kinston. The proposed Queen Street Sewer Rehabilitation Phase 2 work includes the sewer rehabilitation of existing gravity sewer by Cured-in-Place Lining (CIPP) of: approximately 3,636 linear feet of 8-inch, approximately 86 linear feet of 12-inch, approximately 511 linear feet of 18-inch, and approximately 1,023 linear feet of 21-inch; and approximately 32 linear feet of 8-inch gravity sewer replacement; and approximately 3,954 linear feet of 8-inch gravity sewer relocation; and the rehabilitation and replacement of associated manholes and several point repairs.

The above named applicant will receive funding assistance from the State Revolving Fund program to construct the wastewater facilities described above. The North Carolina Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) has conducted a review of the project in accordance with the procedures (NCAC 15A Subchapter 1C) for conformance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act. The Division has determined that this project is below the minor construction activities threshold outlined in 15A NCAC 01C .0408; therefore, the project is exempt from inter-agency review, and the preparation of additional environmental documents is not required.

This determination shall become effective upon its distribution by the Division and will be available on the Division's website (<http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wi/fonsi-dmca-ce>). This determination can be revoked at any time adverse information is made available. The documentation to support this decision will be on file with the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Division of Water Infrastructure, and is available for public scrutiny upon request.
