The BB&T Site in Durham, North Carolina is the site of a former dry-cleaning business that operated from 1963 until 1975. Soil and groundwater at the site are contaminated with the dry-cleaning solvent tetrachloroethene (also called "perc") and its breakdown products. The site is currently in the **Dry-cleaning Solvent Cleanup Act (DSCA) Program**, a voluntary program administered by the N. C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources that oversees the remediation of contaminated dry-cleaning sites.

**BB&T Site Update –March 2012**

**Current Status:**

A Remedial Action Plan (RAP) has been prepared to address contamination on the source property. The RAP is viewable at [www.ncdsca.org](http://www.ncdsca.org), "News and Events". A public meeting was held on March 5, 2012 to discuss the Remedial Action Plan for the former BB&T Site. The public comment period and deadline for comments on the RAP, ended on March 14, 2012. Seventy-one comments were received. DSCA is currently in the process of responding to these comments.
