

### Session Law 2019-37; Senate Bill 648 (Shellfish Aquaculture Bill)

- An act to provide further support to the shellfish aquaculture industry in North Carolina
- Includes requirements for adopting rules





Department of Environmental Quality

- Section 1: Shellfish Aquaculture Enterprise Areas (SEA)
  - Identify moratorium areas for potential SEAs
  - MFC may adopt rules
- Section 2: Pamlico Sound Shellfish Aquaculture Pilot Project
- Section 3: Increase Production and Planting Requirements
  - MFC *shall* adopt rules





- Section 4: Transition of Terminated Leases and Gear Cleanup
- Section 5: Transplanting of Seed Oysters/Clams Prohibited Waters
- Section 6: Administrative Remedy for Shellfish Leasing Appeals
  - MFC *shall* adopt rules, *may* adopt temporary rules
- Sections 7 & 8: Moratorium New Hanover Area/Bogue Sound





- **Section 9**: Reduce User Conflict Study
  - Joint study by DMF and MFC
  - MFC shall adopt rules
- **Section 10**: Penalties/Violations Study
  - DMF, NC Department of Justice (DOJ),
     NC Sentencing and Policy Advisory Commission (SPAC)
- Section 11: Shellfish Loan Program Study
  - NC Coastal Federation
- Section 12: Study Crop Insurance for Shellfish Aquaculture
  - NC Dept. of Agriculture and Consumer Services


- DMF and MFC to study how to reduce user conflict related to shellfish cultivation leases

- Adopt rules and reform internal operating procedures: Mar. 2021





- Shellfish Lease Program is Under-Resourced






#### **Shellfish Leases: Total**

### **Recommendation #1: Regulatory Reform**

- Riparian owner notifications
- Include MFC limit total acres
- 250 ft. setback between shellfish leases
- Developed shoreline setback to 250 ft.
- Marking requirements
- Training requirements
- Administrative remedy
- Minimum clearance for submerged gear on bottom leases



### **Recommendation #2: Program Evaluation**

- Best management practices for industry
- Utilize best available science
- Stakeholders working together to address user conflict issues
- Synchronize reporting and renewal requirements for shellfish leases and aquaculture permits







#### **Recommendation #3: Collaboration**

- Identify further areas of collaboration
- Interstate Aquaculture Workgroup
- Inventory aquaculture information from all states
- Shellfish Aquaculture Training Program







#### **Recommendation #4: Resource Assessment**

• Evaluate staff and funding levels to implement recommendations
