North Carolina Saltwater Fishing Tournament Regulations

The tournament begins January 1, 2024 and ends midnight, December 31, 2025. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD, ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY JANUARY 15, 2025. Fish must be caught in accordance with North Carolina state and federal laws and regulations as well as the NC Saltwater Fishing Tournament rules. Everyone is eligible except a charter boat, captain, a crewman of a for-hire boat, or anyone who offers fish for sale. One angler per citation, there are no associated fees or costs. Eligible waters include all North Carolina sounds, estuaries, surf, and the Atlantic Ocean. All fish must be caught on hook and line. Snagged, mutilated, scaled, speared, frozen, or shot fish are not eligible. All applications must be complete and legible including anglers' information, date, species, catch info, and submitted via mail to the address below or through the online citation application. Harvested fish citation rules: Fish must be weighed by an authorized weighmaster (or his/her representative) at an official weigh station. Application must include fish weight and length and be signed by the angler and weighmaster. Weighmaster reserves the right to cut, open, or mark the fish after it has been weighed. Release citation rules: Angler or mate must touch the fish or the leader. Application must be completed with the number of fish released, length (see exceptions below), and signed by the angler.
