Dear Marine Fisheries Commissioners,

Thank you for the opportunity to weigh in on the direction the MFC should follow regarding North Carolina's valuable Southern flounder stock. Unfortunately, effective management decisions have been avoided and delayed for way too long to insure a sustainable fishery. Timing is crucial. Please adopt measures which will successfully decrease total catch toward the higher end of the recommended range of reductions (i.e. 60%).

I am in favor of incorporating the following management options- ALL and TOGETHER- into the Supplement:

- **Proposal #1: IN ITS ENTIRETY with this selected option:** Trip limit of 36 flounder per valid Standard Commercial Fishing License with maximum of one limit per operation, regardless of the number of valid Standard Commercial Fishing Licenses present.
- **Proposal #2:** The large mesh gill net fishery will close Sept. 16 – Dec. 31 north of Cape Hatteras. South of Cape Hatteras the closure will be Oct. 16 – Dec. 31. (Consequently, the large mesh gill net fishery will not reopen in 2016 based upon adoption of all elements from Proposal #1 above.)
- **Proposal #2:** Recreational hook-and-line and gigs will have no reductions unless a closure from Nov. 1 to Dec. 31 is considered necessary to meet appropriate reductions.

In addition to these proposals, I encourage you to revisit the idea of creating a minimum/maximum size limit (slot), similar to how red drum are managed. According to the Original Fishery Management Plan for Southern Flounder, Feb. 2005, p. 31, "Males achieve smaller sizes than females, rarely exceeding ... 330mm (13 inches) in size (Wenner et al. 1990)." And, from the later FMP Amendment, March 2013, p.26, supported with two additional studies, "Males exceeding ... 13 inches... are uncommon (Wenner et al. 1990; Fischer and Thompson 2004, Takade-Heumacher and Batsavage 2009).

Therefore, requiring a harvest of only 15" and larger flounder will guarantee a 100% removal of only female flounder from the stock. It would seem more desirable to include some male flounder in the harvest as opposed to only targeting the prized, female breeding stock. An added benefit of such a slot could be lower, regulatory discards in both commercial and recreational Southern flounder fisheries, and thus, a reduced total catch.

A second item I offer for future discussion is establishing a Total Allowable Catch (TAC) based on the number of flounder and not pounds of flounder. A trending harvest comprised of mostly shorter fish with a poundage TAC could result in removal of more individual fish than ideal. This better approach can facilitate data collection and processing (MRIP and Trip Tickets) as creel limits for both Commercial and Recreational giggers and hook-and-line fishermen are stated in terms of numbers of fish and not pounds. Such a TAC can easily be applied to the pound net fishery as well. This simplification would allow the use of creel limits to manage flounder stock more directly and effectively.

Thank you again for your time and consideration of my comments. Please show courage in making your decisions and remain focused on the goal: to adopt meaningful and effective changes in the management of our Southern flounder.

WHEREAS, all marine creatures are public trust resources owned equally by all citizens of North Carolina regardless of residency; and,

WHEREAS, the southern flounder fishery is a traditional recreational target of many Nash County residents; and,

WHEREAS, the southern flounder population stocks in North Carolina are classified as "depleted"; and,

WHEREAS, a recent stock assessment conducted by the NC Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF), as well as the peer reviewers, agreed that the stocks are showing no signs of improvement and that harvest of juvenile fish within the population is alarming; and,

WHEREAS, the NC Division of Marine Fisheries (DMF) reports that in 2013 in Nash County 12 individuals held a commercial fishing license, with one of those selling, and 8,700 individuals held a recreational saltwater fishing license; and,



Dear Commissioners,

As a concerned citizen, I am aware of the continued downward slide of NC's depleted Southern Flounder stock. It is well past time to reverse this slide. You now have a real opportunity to make that happen at the Marine Fisheries Commission meeting in August.

I would like to see you do everything necessary to place into temporary rule under the supplement process to the Southern Flounder Fishery Management Plan measures that will support and ensure the following:

1. Reduce the harvest of Southern Flounder by Commercial Fishermen by at least 50%
2. Implement a yearly Total Allowable Catch for commercially harvested Southern Flounder. This TAC should be least 50% lower than the average commercial Southern Flounder harvest of the last 3 years. Without at TAC you cannot have a harvest reduction that will work. An unlimited harvest has led to our depleted fish stock and these fish will not recover until a TAC is in place.
3. Suspend the harvest of Southern Flounder by any and all gill nets. This will achieve most of the 50% reduction requested above and solve many problems for our inshore marine fisheries. The management cost, conflicts, bycatch issues and unsustainable harvest associated with the use of gill nets has created an unmanageable situation for marine fisheries in NC.

Please support these three simple changes and help our Southern Flounder stock begin the recovery that it deserves.

I am writing to comment on the 6 proposals for the management of the Southern Flounder (SF). I am a recreational fisherman (former part time commercial who was squeezed out b/c of the part-time part). I have been fishing in the cape fear area since 1976. My favorite fish to catch has always been Flounder. I have spent countless hours flounder fishing since being a young boy. Needless to say I am passionate about Flounder and thus am writing to you now.

I am writing to encourage you to adopt the most stringent of the 6 proposals put forward, which I consider to be proposal no 1. Based on my observations over the years and especially in the last 10 the SF is in significant decline, which I attribute to pound nets, large mesh gill nets, gigging, and the reduced size limit for commercial fishermen currently in play. It is my opinion that it is time for NC to stop coddling the commercial fishing industry and stand for the protection of our and the countries fisheries including the SF. For the last 3-4 years I've probably kept less than 10% of the flounder I've hooked. The number hooked has also been declining at a sharp rate. It is my opinion that this is due to the numerous giggers and gill nets in the areas I fish as well as the reduction in spawning stock due to pound netting in the sounds. Thanks for finally addressing this issue and please strongly consider the most stringent proposal number 1. Thanks as well for the opportunity to comment.


Dear Commission Members:



I am a Brunswick County resident and have been for 43 years. I moved here in 1972 to start a fishing business. I started chartering out of Tripp's Marina at Shallotte Point. My business name was SEA HAWK CHARTERS, which was the name of my boat. I moved to Ocean Isle in the late 70's fishing out of Sheffield's Grocery Store. I was the first charter boat on Ocean Isle Beach. I ran my offshore/inshore fishing until 2010, which was 38 years. I would still be in that business and wouldn't sold my offshore boat if the Marine Fisheries hadn't gotten into the fishing business making such poor laws and regulations. They started off on the King Mackerel, then went right down the line with different fish. Now they have regulation on all of the species.

Now they have decided to start on the inshore fishing and want to drop the flounder to 1 keeper per person with an 18 inch size limit. We already have only 1 Red Drum keeper per person while South Carolina, a few miles south of us, has a 3 drum limit. I won't go into all of the rules and laws, if I did I would have to have a couple pages in the paper.

I have now fish the backwaters for 5 years. I target flounder, drum and trout. This month I have had 4 flounder trips which we caught 42 flounder total with 29 keepers. Now the Marine Fisheries are saying there are no flounder left, just like they told us all the sharks are gone. I hope the public do not believe this to be true.

The thing about all these regulations is it doesn't hurt only the fishing business but also stops people from coming to rent houses, buy bait, fuel, food, etc. It comes down to hurting all business in the coastal area. Last year, for instance, the North Carolina Marine Fisheries closed the trout season from the first week of February until June 15, 4 months. They said the ice storm shocked the trout. I guess they think the water stayed cold until mid-June. I never saw the first dead trout and I was out on the water a lot.

What their decision did made me call 22 people and tell them not to come down the trout season was closed. It hurt my income, yes, but what about the motels, rental houses, restaurants, gas stations, grocery stores, etc. Also it hurt not just my business but all the others boaters that are trying to make a living from the water.

If you agree with what I am saying you need to call Patricia Smith at 252-726-7021 and let her know you are against more and stricter regulations on our local fish.

No one wants to keep a ridiculous limit of fish, we want fish for our children and grandchildren but we don't want to turn the younger generations against fishing by keeping the limits so low. The proposed regulation are not allowing enough fish to catch for a fish fry after the tourist buy fishing licenses.

Say NO to New Flounder Regulations they are proposing!!

Pound netting is the cleanest fishery the state has because we basically have no bycatch. I've seen a lot of changes in the Fishery Regulations on pound nets thru the years to the point that we really don't have nothing left to give and still make a living. It cost a lot of money to maintain and set these pound nets. It also is labor intensive. Its not like setting crab pots, gill nets, shrimp trawls, etc. It takes a lot of effort & time to set pound nets. We need all the fishing season we currently have, please do not shorten the season any more. We already lost a whole month. (Dec.) The proposal for a minimum size of 15 in. is also devastating for us. I personally don't see a problem with 5. Flo. The last two years have been better than previous years. The closure of gill nets due to turtle interactions should be more than enough reduction in effort to catch 5. Flo. It should be given time to see the results. Dear Commission Members,

Southern Flounder Supplement 2015 RECOMMENDED NOT BASED ON SCIENCE DATA

1. My recommendation is 2,602,390 Pounds of Southern Flounder which was for caught 2008.

NOT Recommended Total Allowable Catch 625,626 pounds.

NC FOLKS, RESTAURANTS, SEAFOOD MARKETS, OUT OF STATE DEALERS want NC Seafood. Local restaurants can not meet demands.

2. Recommend Southern Flounder 8 inches long that is the length traveling through NC waters. (Size was increased to provide CCA Trophy fish.) In 2014 half of the state was open to set gill nets only 28 nights due to interactions with protected species. Which no one has provided Turtle counts numbers which is beyond the natural Balance of Marine Life since reductions of Turtles have BEEN in place for years. With the numerous numbers and out of balance TURTLES WILL BE EATING MORE MARINE LIFE THAN HUMANS.

3. Commercial Fishermen are to be allowed to catch fish 7 days per week **not** 4 days.

4. Gill Nets are to be allowed to be set year round as in 2010.

In February the Division of Marine Fisheries presented the latest stock assessment, which it declared could not be used to make management decisions. The assessment failed peer review. Director Louis Daniels told the commission the stock showed signs of concern which prompted its decision to seek permission to develop a supplement. The SUPPLEMENT DOES NOT ALLOW COMMERCIAL TO CATCH SOUTHERN FLOUNDER. Marine life has been in the coastal waters of NC since country was founded.

Marine Life is still in the waters unless POLLUTION OR EXCESS GROUND NUTRIENTS RUN-OFF KILLS MARINE LIFE.

5. By Catch is 15-20 percent.

6. No closures by dates until Flounder leave area.

7. Commercial giggers will be limited to Southern Flounder 8 inches and longer in length and no limits for number of fish. Commercial fishing: Flounder length is 8 inches or longer for all caught

8. Closings will occur when Commercial Fishing Flounder Quota 2,602,390 pounds are met.

9. Flounder Trawling caught more Flounder in the past, use Turtle Excluder devices.

In 2008 Southern Flounder caught was 2,602,390 pounds with a value of \$ 5,650,295. In 2008 total Finfish caught is 27,621,065 pounds with a value of \$ 34,420,027; total shellfish 43,579,163 pounds with a value of \$ 52,389,826. Total pounds is 71,200,227 with Total value of \$ 86,809,853.

Then, new genetic studies led scientists to conclude that southern flounder are not a distinct population in North Carolina as previously thought, but part of a coast wide stock. Biologists at the division say that is why their stock assessment cannot be used to accurately determine whether the stock is overfished or viable. Will Smith one of the biologists responsible for the assessment told the commission it is like trying to balance an account without knowing exactly how many debits and credits have been made. Data on the number of flounder leaving North Carolina, returning, or coming from elsewhere is currently unavailable. **A supplement is intended to be an emergency measure. An emergency situation does not exist on flounder. Conservative measures have been in place for southern flounder for over 35 years. Science does not support the claim that southern flounder are on the verge of collapse. North Carolina needs an independent review of information used in the stock assessment by fisheries experts to determine whether a 'multi-decadal decline in recruitment as abundance' as stated by Division of Marine Fisheries is evident from these data.**

Why the rush? My thoughts are to destroy Commercial Fishing in NC waters. NC Fisheries Association indicates if there is a problem, we need to address it. Reports from NOAA are seatrout and menhaden prior stock assessments underestimated the health of those stocks and resulted to unnecessary harvest reductions. (Menhaden fishing is no longer in NC.) Loss value resulted for state, money, income, and jobs.

NOAA has released Fisheries Economics of the US covering the year 2012 and it should be required reading for all in Congress involved in reauthorization of the Magnuson-Stevens Act. 2012 report provides Commercial and Recreational Fisheries. Reports are this is the first economics comparison report of Commercial and Recreational Fisheries provided.

Sales Recreation = \$ 58 Billion, Sales Commercial Fisheries = \$ 140 Billion

Value added to the National Economy Recreational = \$ 30 Billion, Value Commercial Fisheries = \$ 60 Billion

Terms of jobs Recreational = employed 380,000, Jobs Commercial Fisheries = 1.27 Million people (producers, processors, distributors, wholesales, and seafood retailers).

“To put this another way, the value of the power yacht industry is the primary “value” of recreational fishing. It takes just a simple statement on a form to say a \$ 300,000 power boat – used for cruising, parties, and fishing is part of the recreation fishing industry.”

Less than 20% of the jobs in the industry come from guides, boat operators, tackle shops, motel owners etc.

Commercial Fisheries is totally different. Seafood Retailers generated the largest number of job and value impacts, for 610,000 jobs \$ 32 Billion in sales. Followed by import sector 207,000 jobs and wholesalers and distributors 57,000 jobs. The remaining jobs were in harvesting and processing.

Economic benefits of the commercial seafood sector penetrate all parts of the US throughout the entire economy. It is true that fishermen in Alaska is in supporting the jobs of dozens of people throughout the rest of the country.

Striking thing about recreational employment was how much of it was concentrated in Florida. For example, out of 360,000 jobs in 2012, fully 30% are in Florida alone. (FDA reports Florida is a state that has more mislabeled fraud seafood 50-75% percent, more legal cases, National Fishermen Ass.)

Recreational fishery’s value is primarily concentrated in boat manufacturers and equipment makers and it is highly regionally concentrated in Florida, Gulf States, and North Carolina.

For the Commercial industry, the value and jobs created spread through the entire country, while for the recreational sector, the jobs and value are concentrated in a few states and industries. Florida is the only state with more jobs attributable to recreational fishing than commercial.

Commercial Fisheries provides more jobs and value by a wide margin.

“The analysis fully supports the purposes of the Magnuson Stevens Act, which is that if the marine resources of the US are to be used to benefit the entire country, the Commercial Seafood Industry is by far the most effective and democratic way to the accomplish that goal.”

NOAA is in the cabinet level of Department of Commerce.

From 2013 – 2015 present date, Division of NC Marine Fisheries refused to follow or discuss benefits of Trawling. Review Deehr, R.A. (2012) Measuring the Ecosystem Impacts of Commercial Shrimp Trawling

and Other Fishing Gear in Core Sound, North Carolina Using Ecological Network Analysis. East Carolina University, Coastal Resources Management Program, April 25, 2012. Research funded by NC Sea Grant Project. Lots of Commercial Fishermen worked to obtain the data and worked on research. Commercial Fishermen wanted these findings presented.

What did the Division of Marine Fisheries and few NC Representatives Republicans, Thom Tillis and Ruth Samuelson do? Two years of promoting Closing Trawling advocating with NC CCA

NO RECOMMENDATIONS HAVE BEEN FOLLOWED TO:

1. ENRICH PROMOTE MARINE SEA LIFE, and
2. DISPERSE DEAD SOUND BOTTOM AND DISPERSE POLLUTION.

Where there is NO TRAWLING THE SOUND BOTTOMS ARE DEAD WITH NO MARINE LIFE.

Within the past 2 years the Leadership has promoted stopping TRAWLING, which creates more DEAD SEA BOTTOM AND LESS Marine LIFE. . DEAD SEA BOTTOM IS 1 FOOT TO 5 FEET OF BLACK MUD POLLUTION AND NO MARINE LIFE.

To improve Marine Sea Life and make Fisheries Industry productive, please begin to open more Nursery areas and coastal waters and oceans to Trawling to DISPERSE the POLLUTION and PROMOTE MARINE SEA LIFE. For the past 2 years Division of Marine Fisheries have not provided leadership for Commercial Fishing Industries. Sea Grant study found that the number of seafood processors declined by 36 percent between 2000 and 2011. The economic value of North Carolina's catch has declined from about \$ 109 million in 1995 to \$ 79 million in 2013. Federal and state regulations hinder the supply of fish. In the report, fishermen say that regulations restrict where, when, how and what they can harvest. Sea Grant Specialist provided "This N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries is trying to use more adaptive fishery management techniques, but for many fish stocks, quick-look measures of harvest abundance do not exist."

NC Seafood Festival has taken place for 28 years. The average attendance is 185,000. It is the largest festival east of Raleigh. In 2010 the Festival was the winner of Best Event in the Southeast. NC people enjoy and love NC Local Seafood.

Leadership of NC Secretary of Environmental and Natural Resources and Division of Marine Fisheries Commission has failed to promote NC Commercial Fishing Industry.
