PROCLAMATION TO SUPPORT STOCKING THE TAR AND PAMLICO RIVERS WITH STRIPED BASS

WHEREAS, The County of Beaufort requests the Division of Marine Fisheries and the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission continue to stock Striped Bass in the Tar River and the Pamlico River; and

WHEREAS, the County of Beaufort is a Tier 1 county. The economic benefit that is gained by fishermen spending money on gas, food, bait and fishing tackle helps the County. The County considers fishing for Striped Bass an industry and it cannot afford to lose another industry; and

WHEREAS, the spawning grounds of the Tar River cannot maintain the Striped Bass stock due to several reasons such as silt resulting in shallow water and no dam to adjust the water flow to promote a successful spawning. Data indicate that there is only a 2% successful spawn rate in the Tar River which is hardly enough to maintain a viable stock.

NOW THEREFORE, the Beaufort County Board of Commissioners respectfully request the continuation of stocking the Tar River and the Pamlico River with Striped Bass and that this proclamation be forwarded to the following people:
