




North Carolina Commercial Landings (pounds and value)




North Carolina Recreational Harvest (pounds and numbers)



North Carolina Recreational Catch (harvest & releases)




North Carolina Commercial Landings (by area)








Commercial Fishing Effort




Recreational Fishing Effort




Commercial Fishing Licenses (by license year)



Recreational Fishing Licenses (by calendar year)




Commercial Participants (*Top 5 by county of residence in 2015*)







Recreational Participants (Top 5 by county of residence in 2015)






Percent change from five year average (2010-2014): Commercial









Top Five Species – Commercial Spiny Dogfish




Top Five Species – Commercial Summer Flounder




Top Five Species – Commercial Atlantic Croaker



Percent change from five year average (2010-2014): Recreational




Top Five Species – Recreational Southern Flounder






