Oyster Base Plan



- Add a summary of other state's methods/findings (Delaware/Maryland)
- Economic impact
  - Consider directed trips in analysis (top 30 participants)
  - Consider economic impacts due to area closures (Hyde County)





Oyster Base Plan



- Strengthen the tie into the CHPP
- Consider adding a way to report shellfish die-off observations
- Highlight the importance of oyster habitat on other species
  - Add to species table notes to symbolize if fish is overfished/overfishing
- Mapping
  - Include all oyster mapping data into plan
  - add exploring novel mapping methods of natural reefs as a research need





Habitat & Enhancement Oyster Programs



- Site selection information
  - More detail Habitat Suitability Index → layers, weights, scoring
  - Place further emphasis on constraints of USACE permit for cultch
- Cultch Planting Program
  - Lack of shell available → exported to other states
  - Start tapping into cultch monitoring data (a step towards stock assessment)





Oyster Mechanical Harvest Issue Paper



- Trigger sampling monitoring for open/closure of mechanical harvest areas
  - Methodology will be revised (independent of FMP process)
  - AC agrees with revamping methods for better in-season management
- Overall support in incorporating the cultch planting program (and increase planting efforts)
- Consider ways to assign harvest locations (cultch vs wild reefs; specific management areas)
- Extent of deep-water closure areas
  - Some thought areas should be minimized, some thought gear damage required greater closure
  - need to monitor areas over time for recovery



Intertidal Oyster Commercial Hand Harvest Info Paper



- Overall concern about the unknown amount of recreational harvest in southern region
  - Recognized importance of filling data gap
- Research needs
  - Sentinel site monitoring of intertidal oysters (possible stock assessment data)
  - Alternative materials (other than marl) for southern region cultch planting







- Add further details on demographics of participants in mechanical fishery
  - License holder's vs operational crew
- Add comparison between private harvest and commercial harvest
  - Graphical comparison over recent years
  - Noted that aquaculture has been slow to grow
  - Limited seed suppliers in NC





Hard Clam Mechanical Commercial Harvest Issue Paper



- Input on management recommendations
  - Don't phase out the fishery
    - Supplemental income for retired participants
    - Loss of heritage between generations (and passing gear down)
  - Cost to enforce the fishery
    - Inquiries to number of violations reported in mechanical clam fishery
    - Suggested to simplify regulations, such as boundary lines
  - Highlighted the importance of SAV and water quality issues
    - Protecting SAV habitat shouldn't come at the cost of mechanical clam fishery
    - Reference the CHPP and its emphasis on SAV
- Research topics to emphasize
  - Quantify mechanical gear disturbance impacts on SAV habitat





Recreational Shellfish Harvest Issue Paper



- Discussed recreating the 1991 recreational survey
  - Estimate the number of trips and participants
  - If participation has continued or grown, the impact could be significant
  - Necessary for stock assessment
- Overall recognition of importance & supported the collection of recreational harvest data
  - License should be the end goal
  - Recommended using survey or permit in meantime
- Raised the point of linking public health concerns to economic impacts
  - Improve public outreach and education on safe harvest, consumption
  - Potential impacts of Vibrio cases on the commercial fisheries
