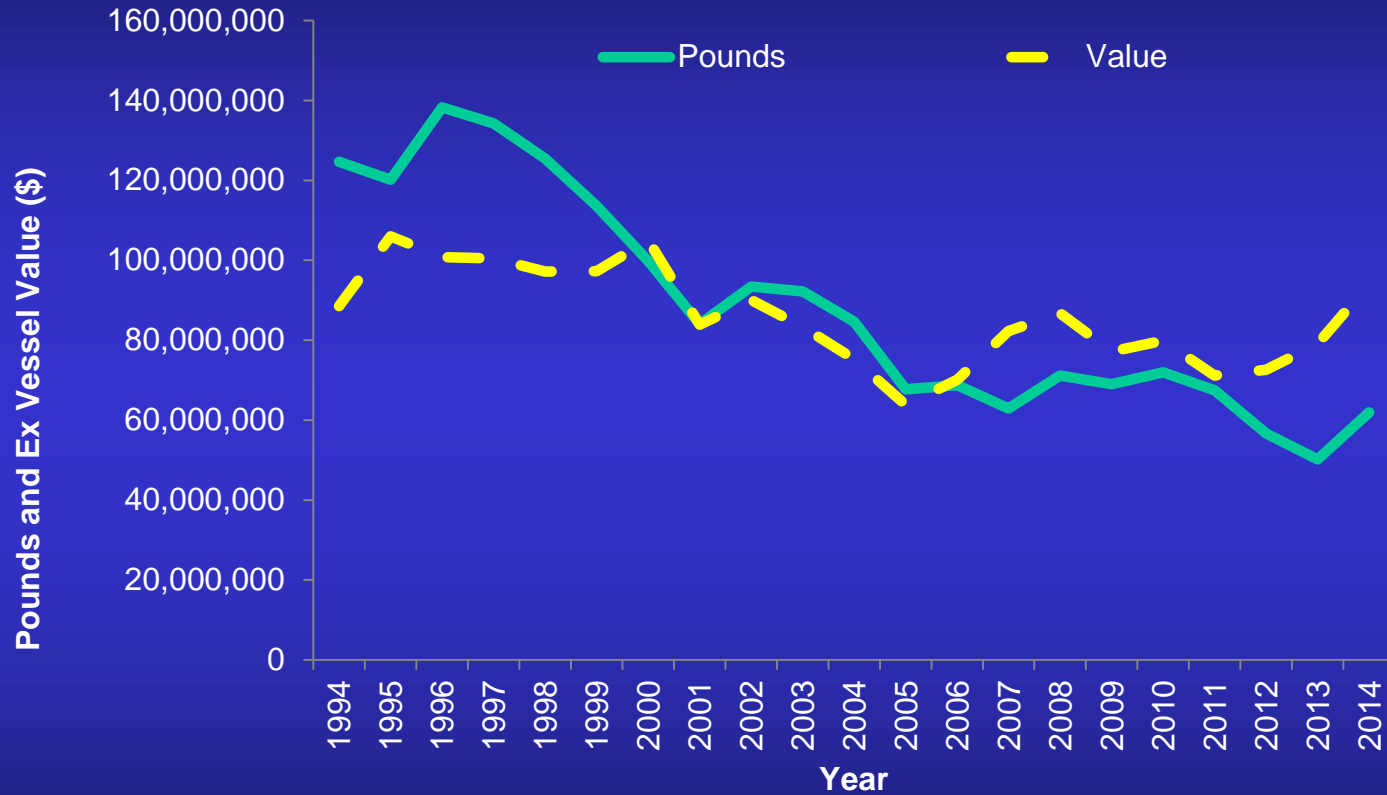

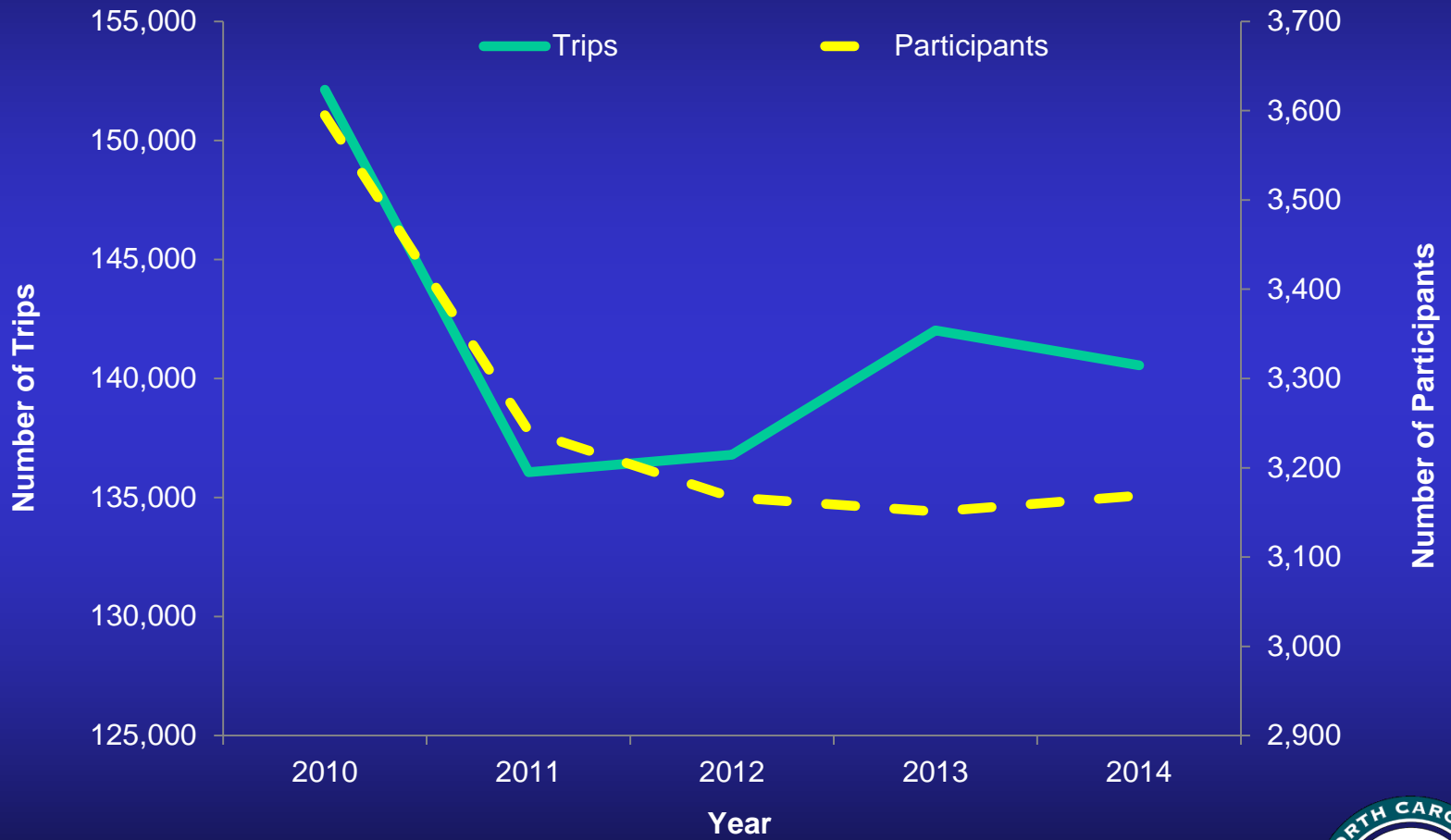

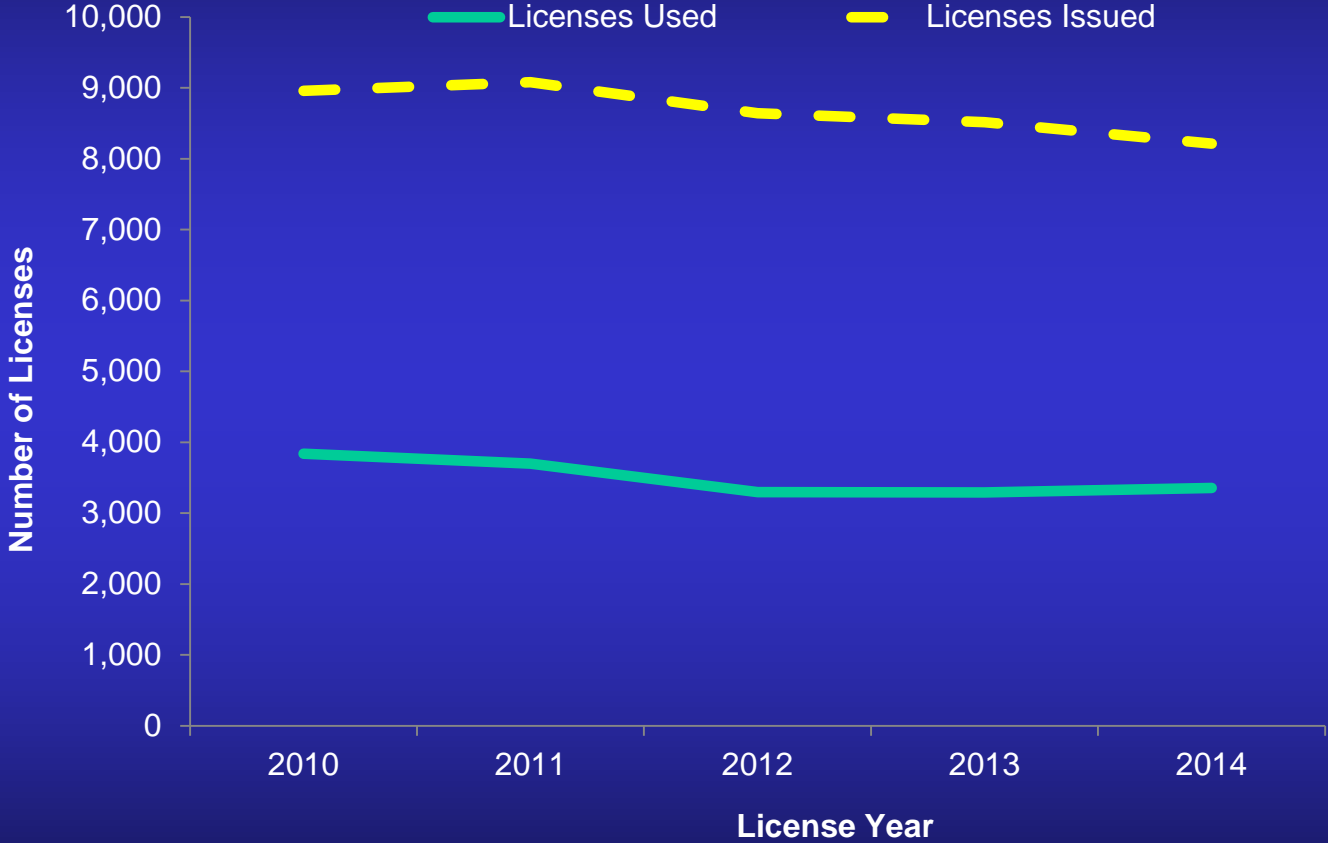
Total Landings and Ex-Vessel Value



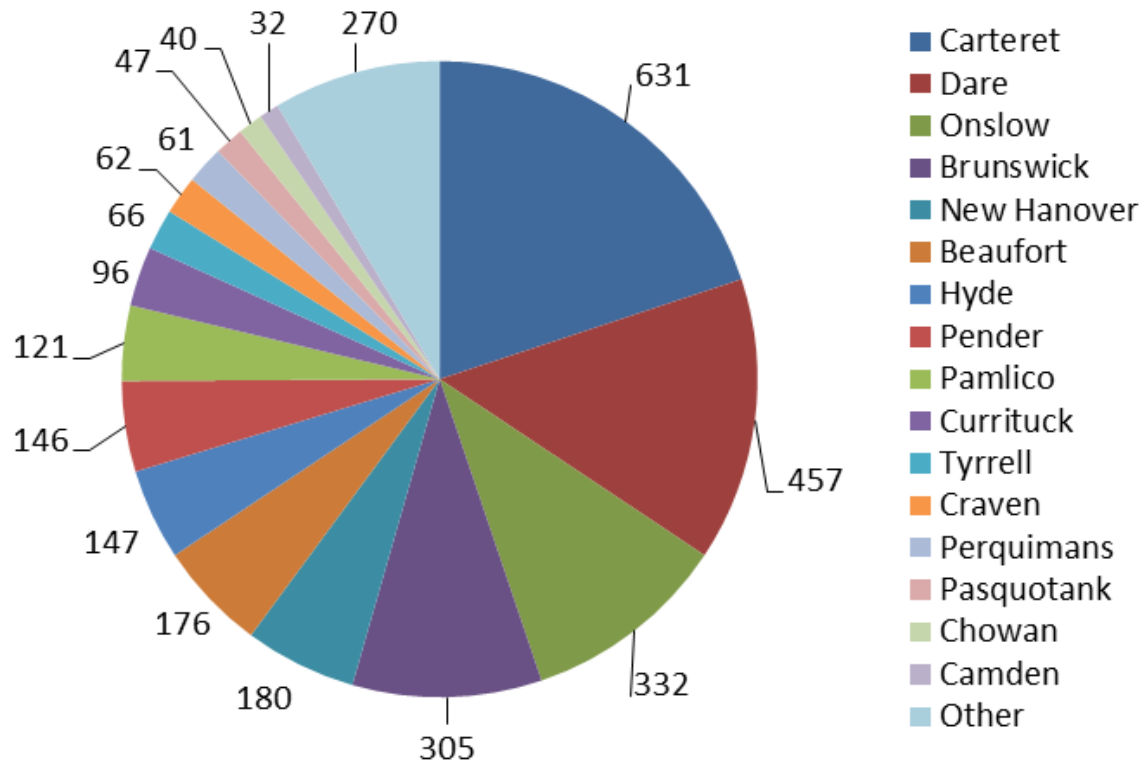
Total Effort



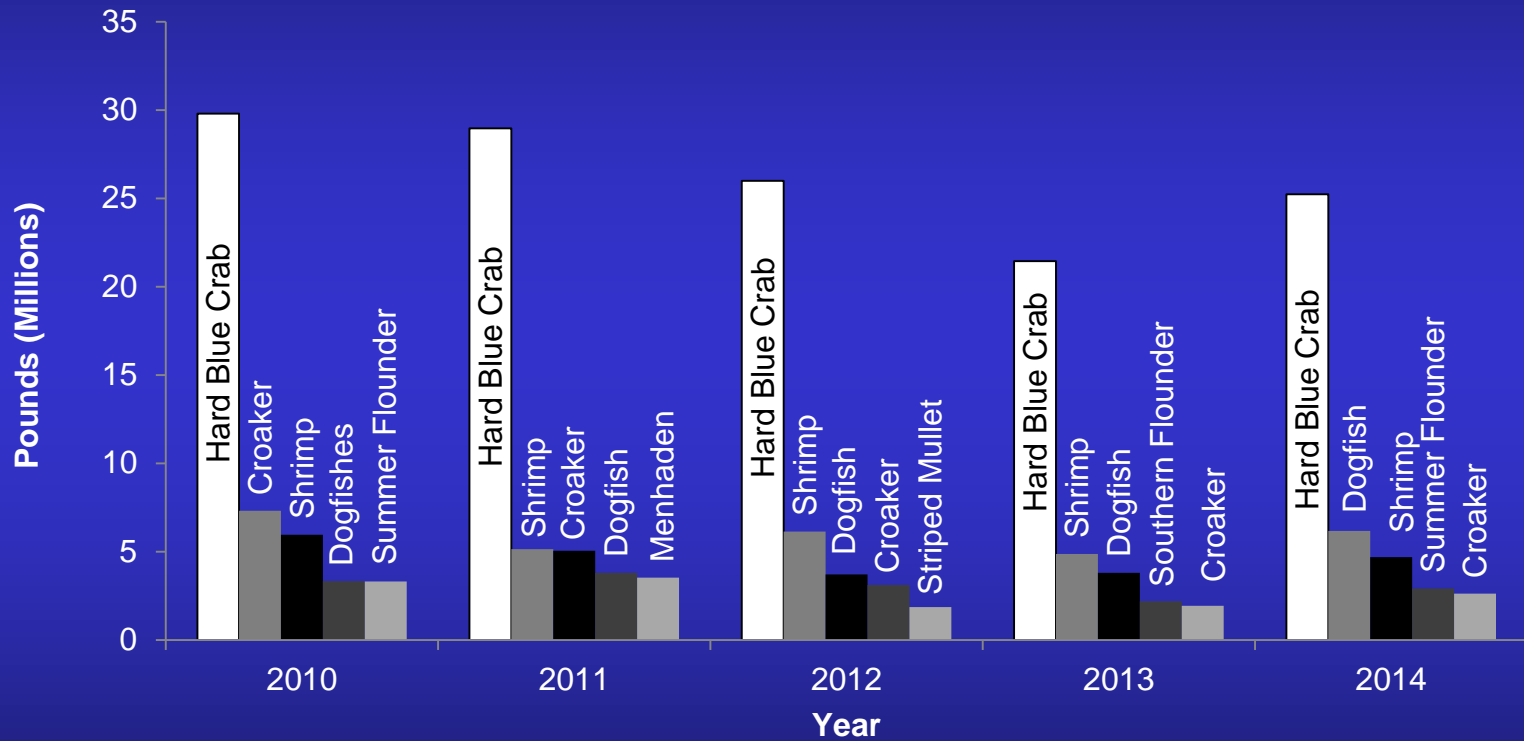

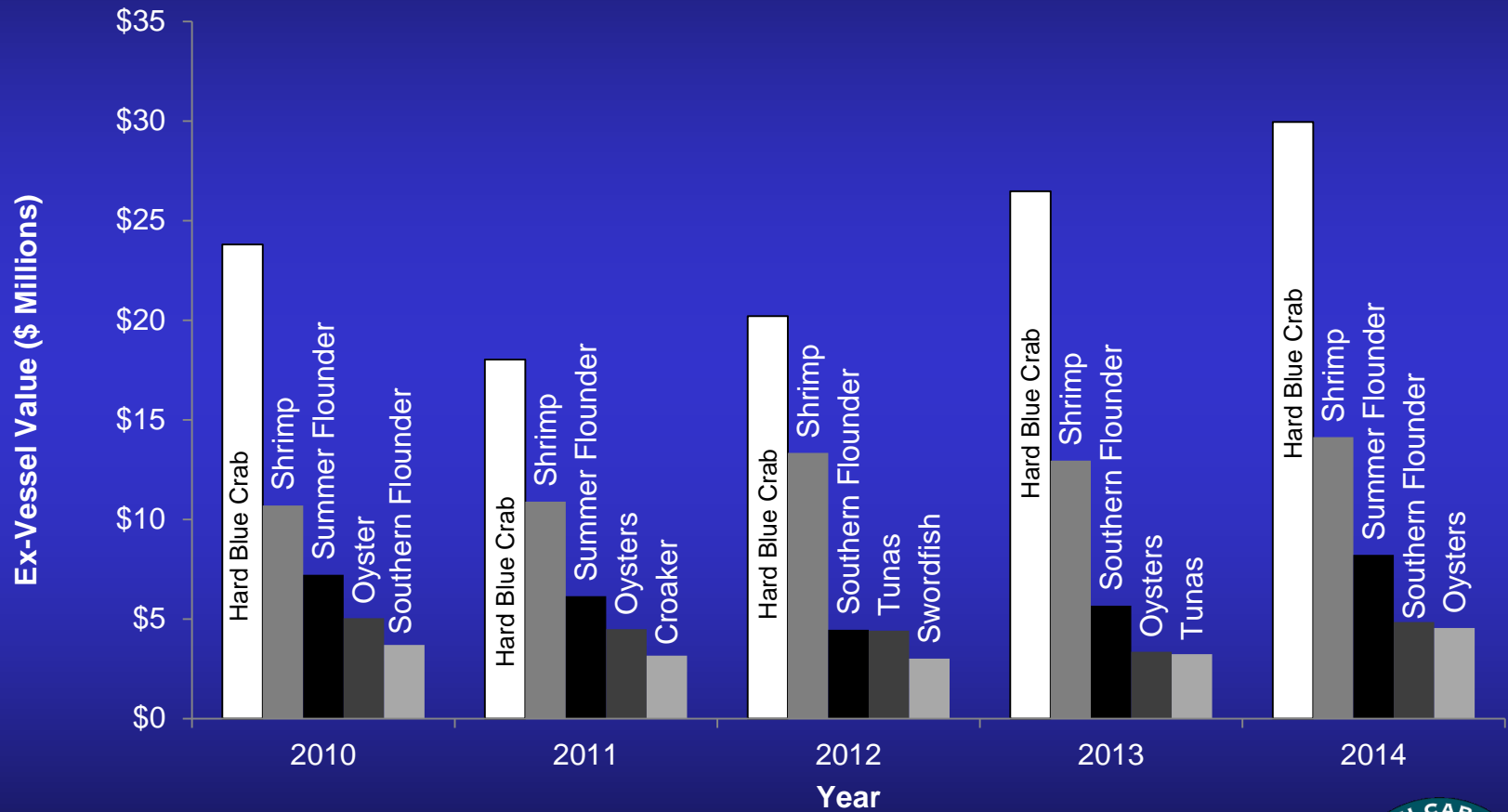

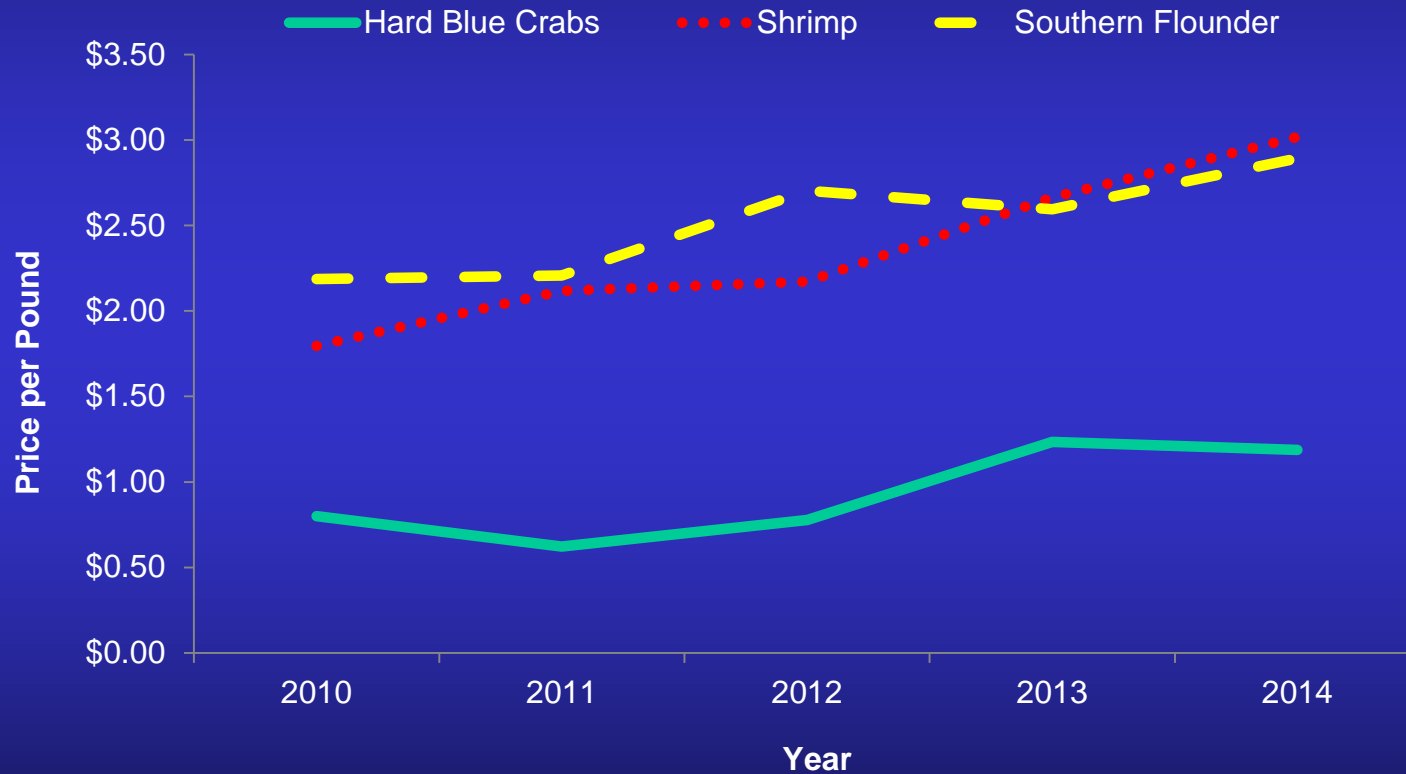
Top Five Species-Pounds



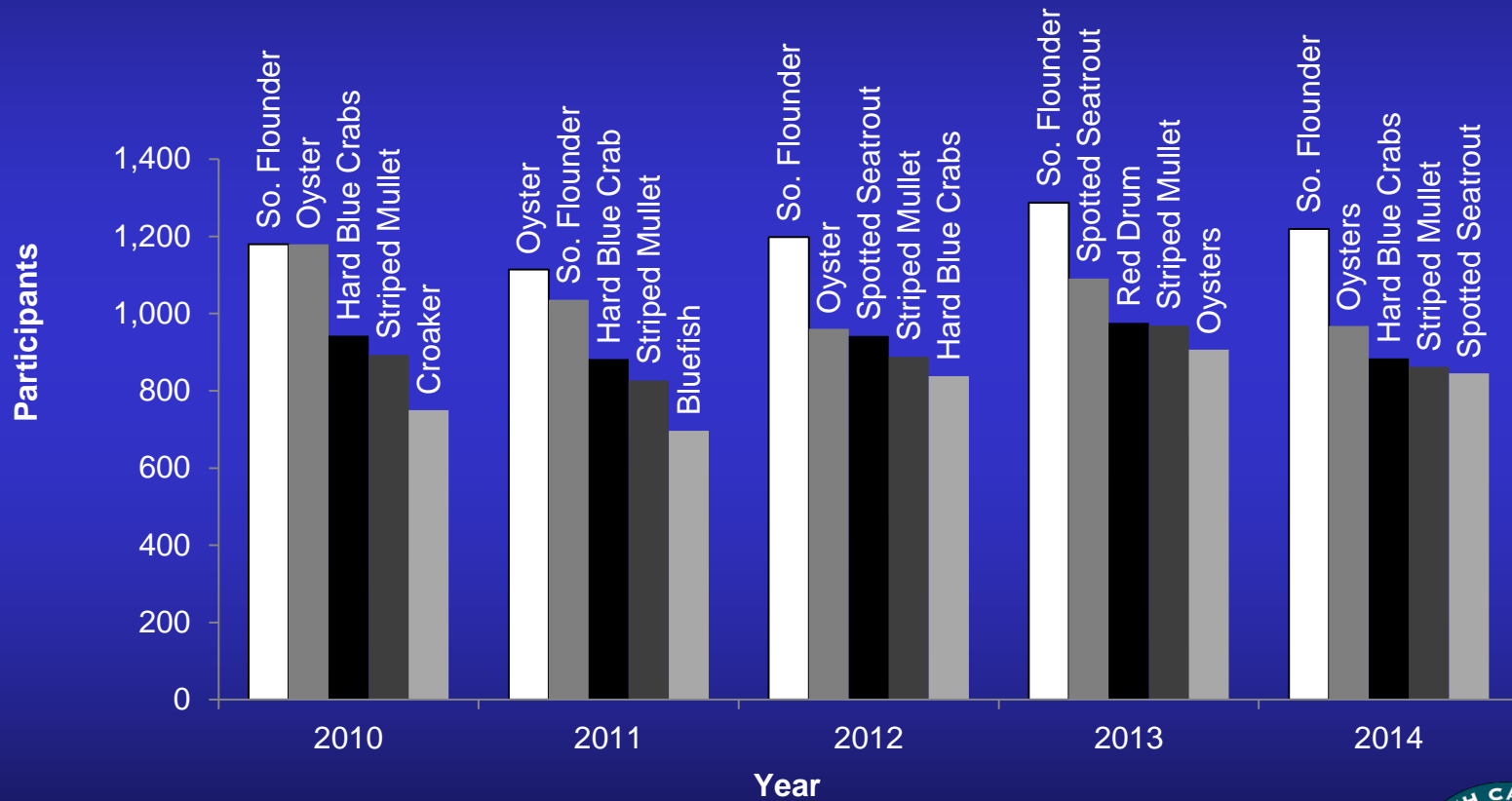
Top Five Species-Ex-Vessel Value



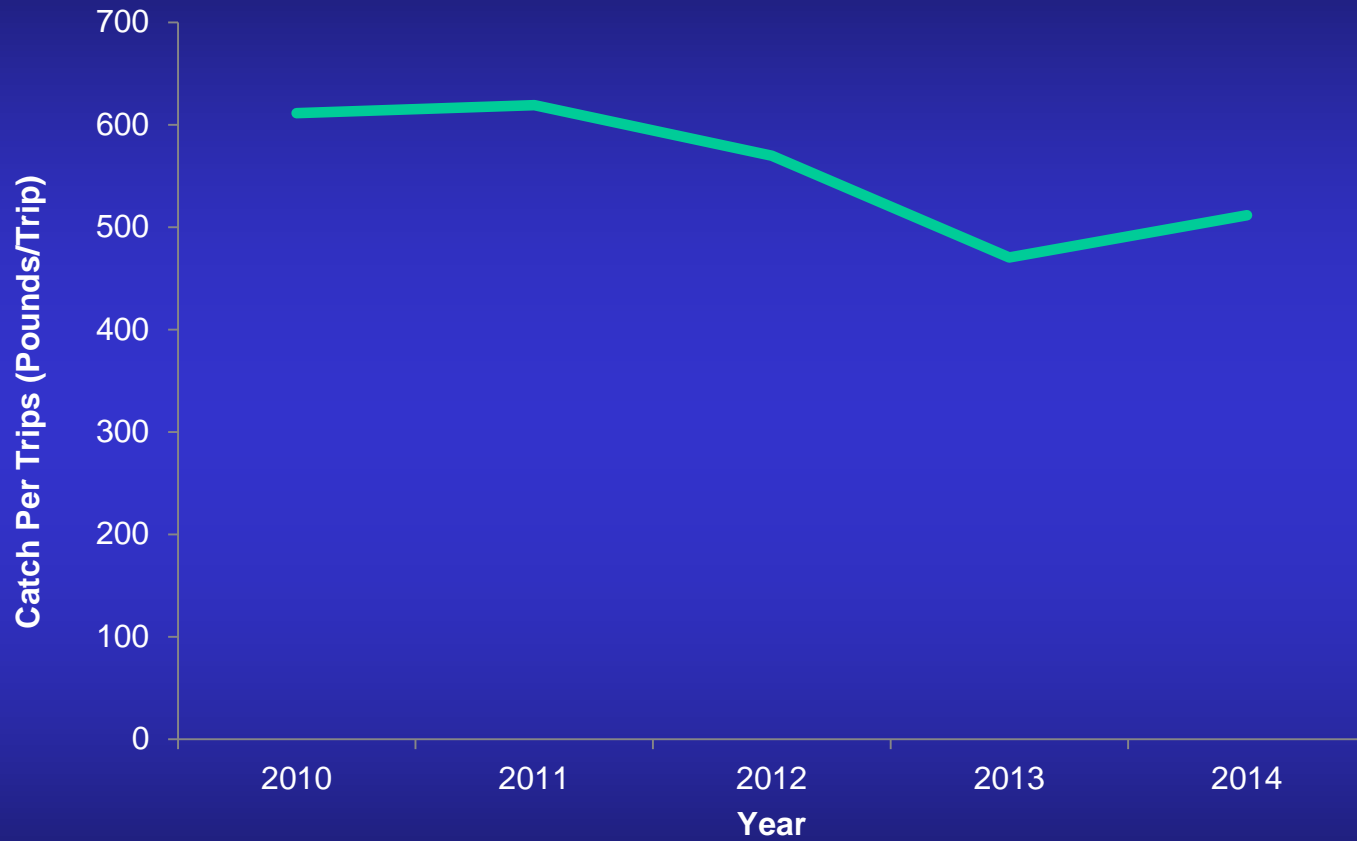
Trends in Price per Pound

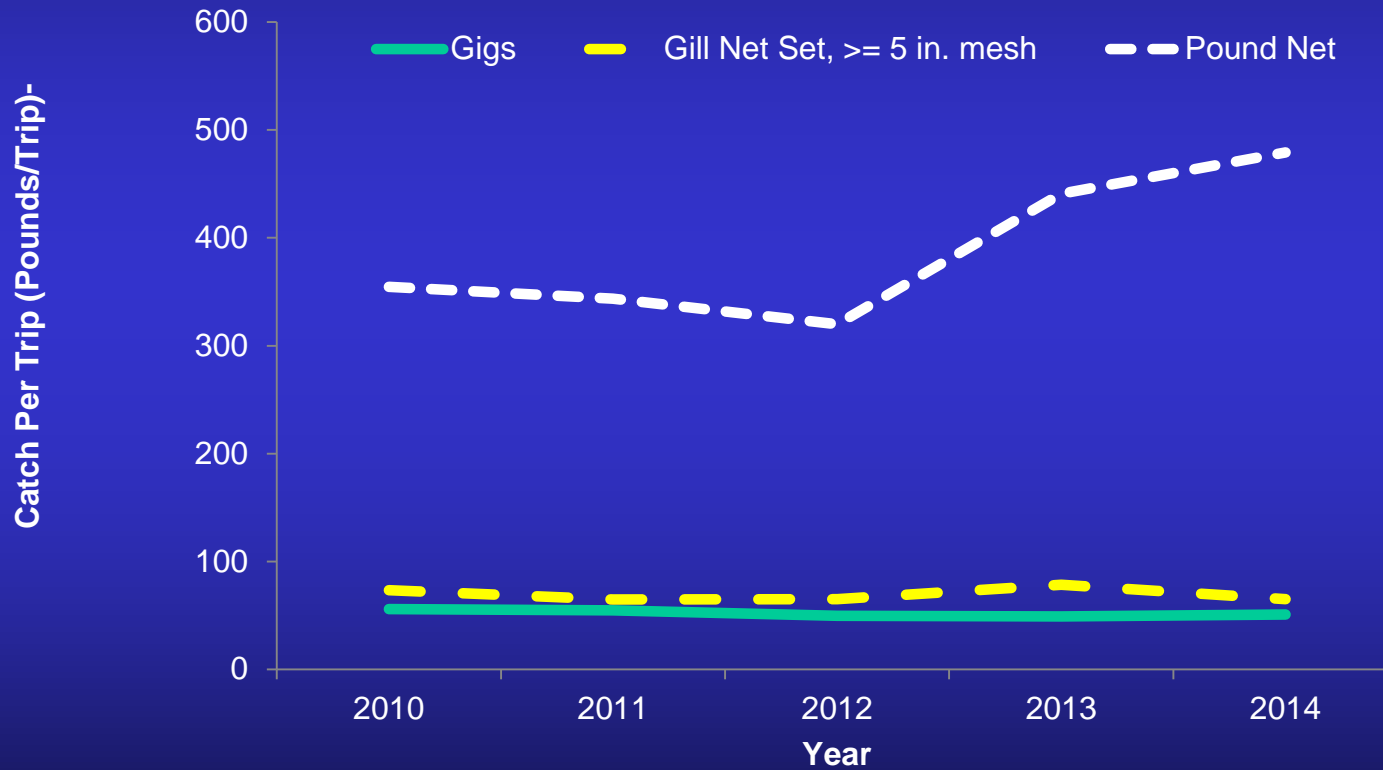
Catch Per Trip-Blue Crab



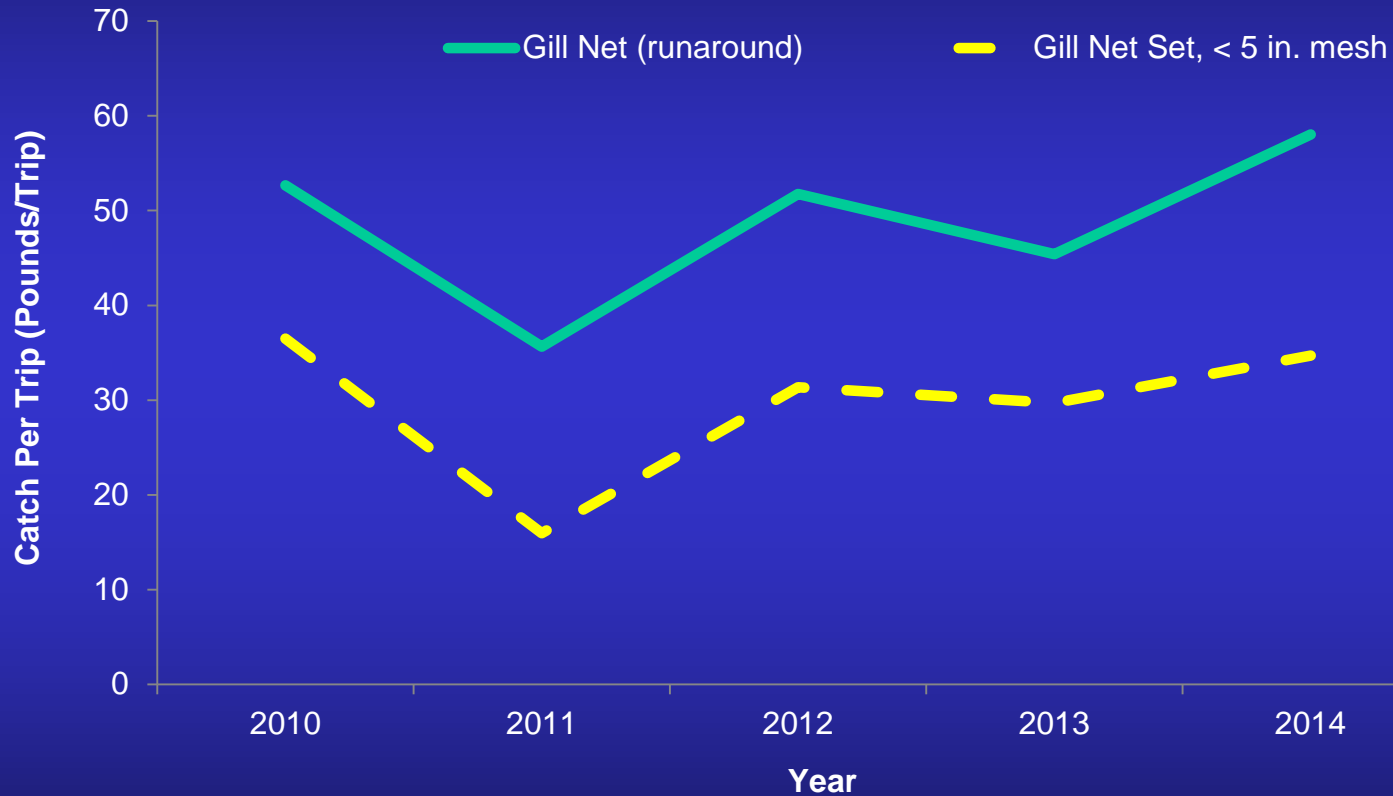
Catch Per Trip-Shrimp



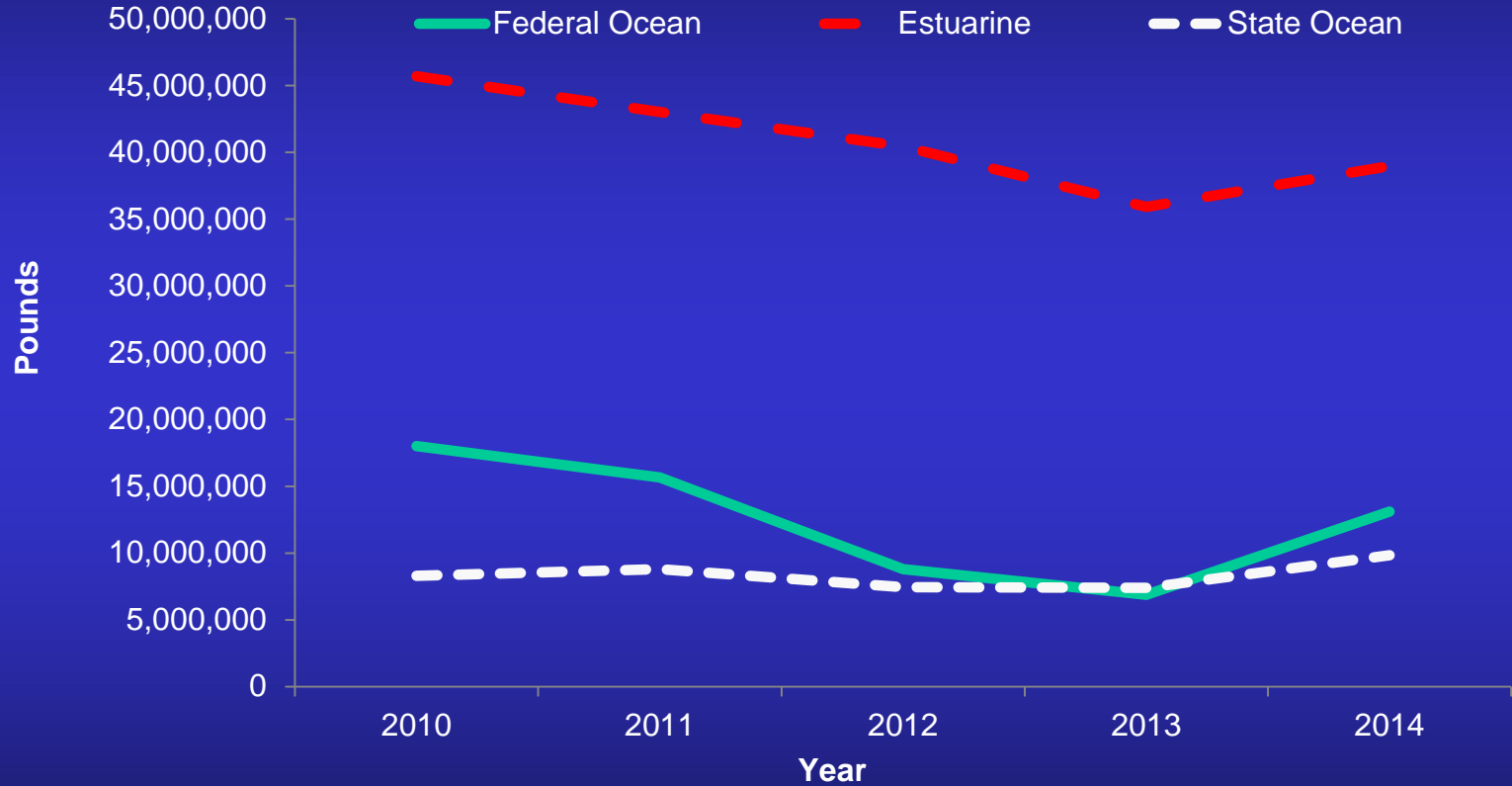
Catch Per Trip-Southern Flounder



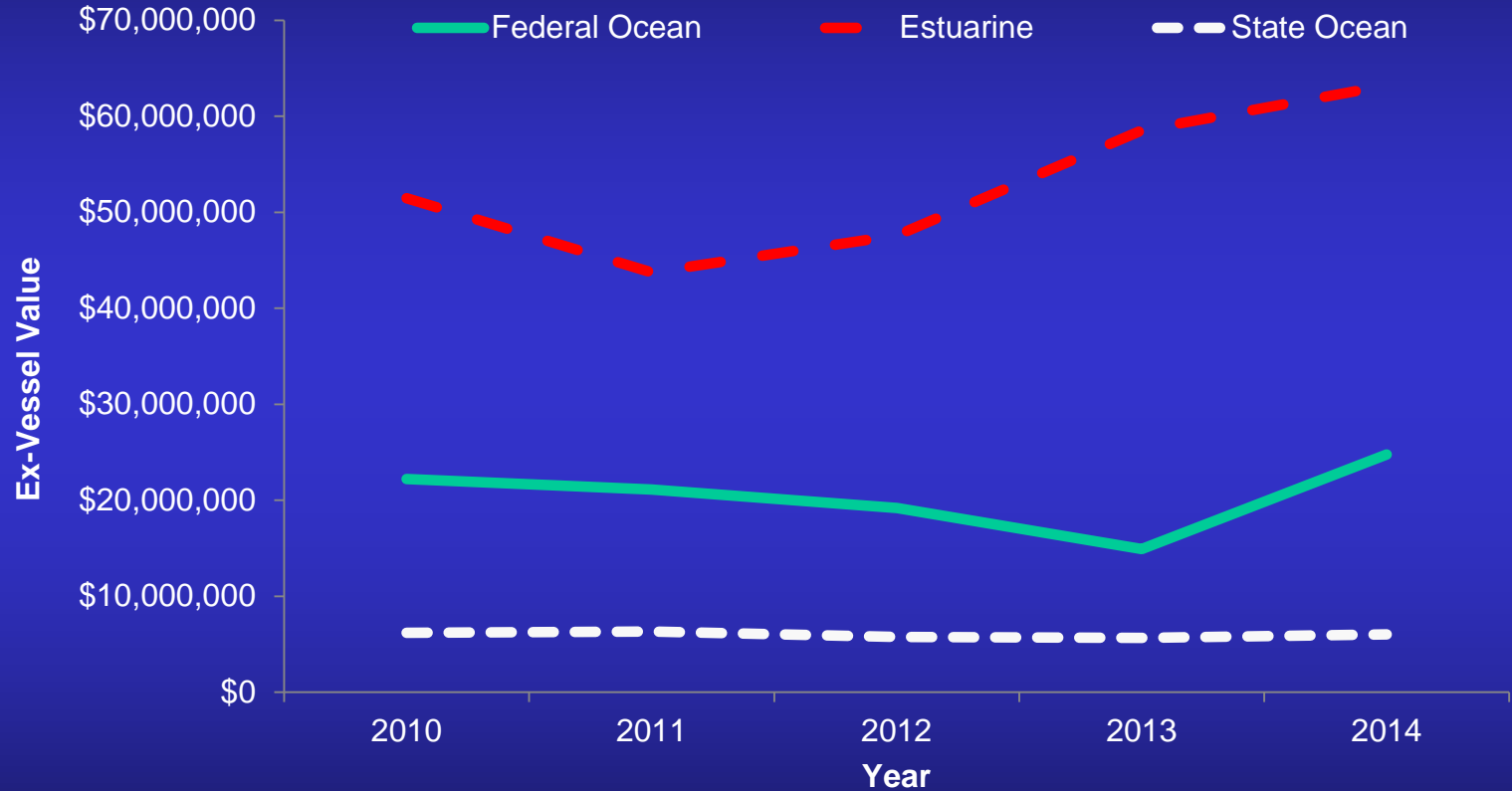

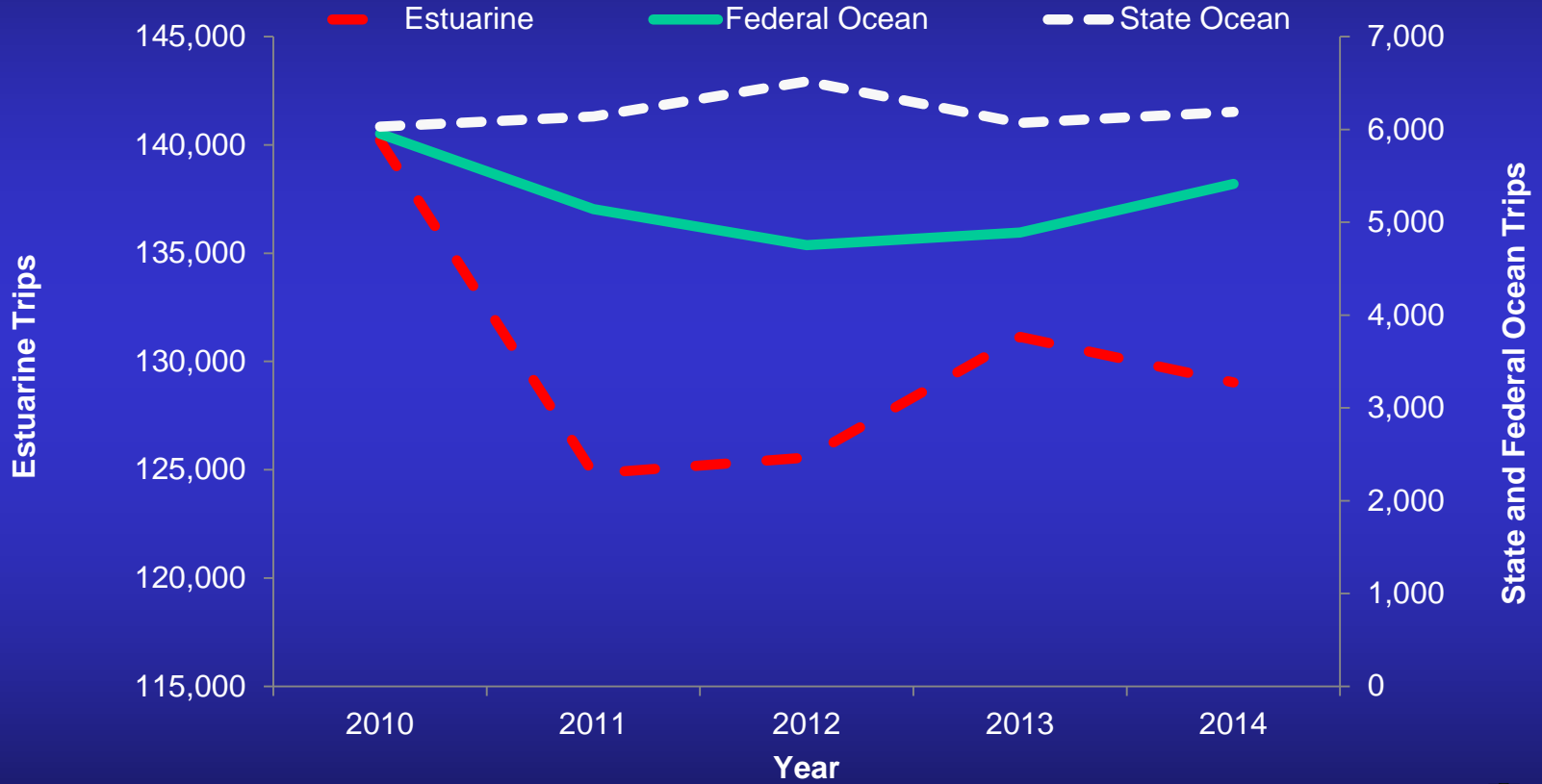
Landings by Area

Summary

- Landings increased substantially last year, by 23% from 2013.
- Value has increased over the last four years, increased by 19% from 2013.
- Hard blue crabs and shrimp continue to rank in top five in pounds and value.
- Southern flounder and oysters always ranked high in effort.
- Majority of landings, value, and effort occurs in the estuarine waters.
