SUBJECT: Conservation Fund Committee Meeting

The Marine Fisheries Commission's Conservation Fund Committee met on Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at 10 a.m. at the Division of Marine Fisheries Headquarters, 3441 Arendell Street, Morehead City, N.C. The Conservation Fund Committee meeting was held to review a proposal from the Division of Marine Fisheries for the James J. Francesconi Memorial Artificial Reef Project. The following attended:

Chairman Mark Gorges called the meeting to order at 10 a.m.

FUND BALANCE

Division staff lead Randy Gregory advised the Committee of the unobligated Conservation Fund balance approximately \$106,000.00. The Governor's Cup just began for 2015 raising the balance an additional \$2000.00. Chairman Gorges asked how the funds came from the Governor's Cup

program. Mr. Gregory explained that \$100.00 of the Governor's Cup registration fee goes to the Conservation Fund and the remaining \$25.00 goes to the Division to support the program.

PROPOSAL FOR THE JAMES J. FRANCESCONI MEMORIAL ARTIFICIAL REEF PROJECT

Garry Wright reviewed the proposal for the James J. Francesconi Memorial Artificial Reef Project requesting for \$10,000.00 from the Conservation Fund. Mr. Wright explained this project was to sink a 180 foot menhaden vessel which would honor Jim Francesconi, the late division artificial reef coordinator. The project is seeking many different funding sources including the North Carolina Division of Motor Vehicles license plate program to develop North Carolina's artificial reefs, the Big Rock Blue Marlin Tournament, an internet GoFundMe account and several private donors. Tim Mullane of American Marine Group has offered the vessel at an estimated cost of \$115,000, which is a sizeable price reduction compared to recently sunken vessels. The vessel will be sunk at AR-330 located approximately 12 nautical miles SW of Beaufort Inlet with a July/August 2015 deployment.

Mark Gorges moved to send the James J. Francesconi Memorial Artificial Reef Project with funding up to \$10,000.00 forward to the Marine Fisheries Commission for consideration, seconded by Kelly Darden. Motion carries 2-0.
