






N.C. ANGLER TRIPS (all modes)

















1989-2014 N.C. Recreational Fishing Angler Trips by Area Fished








How Does North Carolina Rank in **Recreational Angler Trips Coastwide 2014?**










1989-2014 N.C. Recreational Summer and Southern Flounder Landings






1989-2014 N.C. Recreational Red Drum Catch






1989-2014 N.C. Recreational Red Drum Landings
