


## Sustainable Fisheries Plan

- Requirement of Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission to Amendment 3 since Jan. 1, 2013
- Required by all states that have American shad fisheries (except catch and release fisheries)
- Approved by the North Carolina Marine Fisheries Commission in November 2012




## Albemarle Sound/Roanoke System







## 2017 American Shad Management Measures

The American Shad Work Group elected status quo for 2017 American shad management measures in all systems and a full review of the plan, as scheduled, in 2017.

#### Albemarle Sound/Roanoke System

- Recreational: 10 fish shad aggregate, one American shad limit
- Commercial: March 3 March 24

Neuse River

- Recreational: 10 fish shad aggregate, one American shad limit
- Commercial: Feb. 15 April 14

Tar/Pamlico River

- Recreational: 10 fish shad aggregate
- Commercial: Feb. 15 April 14

Cape Fear River

- Recreational: 10 fish shad aggregate, five American shad limit
- Commercial: Feb. 20 April 11

#### All Other Areas

- Recreational: 10 fish shad aggregate
- Commercial: Feb. 15 April 14
