Flounder Dealer Permit (Atlantic Ocean)

What Activities Require This Permit? Licensed fish dealers purchasing greater than 100 lbs. of flounder per day per commercial fishing operation harvested by trawl from the Atlantic Ocean.

What Is The Purpose of This Permit? In order to monitor the quota, the Division of Marine Fisheries needs to know which dealers are going to be participating in the fishery in order to determine who needs to submit daily quota monitoring reports.

Who Issues This Permit? N.C. Division of Marine Fisheries, License and Statistics Section.

How Much Will This Permit Cost? No cost.

What Are My Payment Options for Permit Application Fees? Not applicable.

If Paying by Check, Who do I Make the Check Payable to and Where Do I Send the Check? Not applicable.

How Long Will It Take To Review My Application? No review required.

How Long Is My Permit or License or Certificate Valid? Permits are valid for up to one fiscal year (July 1st to June 30th) and expire on June 30th.

Notes/Comments: A valid fish dealer license is required to obtain this permit. There are daily reporting requirements associated with this permit during the ocean flounder trawl season. Seasons and trip limits for the trawl fishery are established by proclamation. Outside of that season there is a 100 lb. limit on the amount of flounder from the ocean that dealers may purchase.
