Public Comment Period: Dura-Supreme - Statesville

AIR QUALITY PERMIT OVERVIEW

Dura-Supreme LLC – Statesville applied for a Title V air quality permit to construct and operate a wood cabinet manufacturing facility, with woodworking, gluing, assembly and surface coating operations.

Air emissions from the woodworking operations will be controlled with an active exhaust/collection system vented to baghouse dust collectors. The surface coating booths will use panel filters to control particulate emissions.


Facility Location

Dura-Supreme is at 607 Meacham Road in Statesville, Iredell County. The address is off West Front Street and near the I-40 exit onto Garner Bagnal Boulevard.

Facility Emissions

The facility would be considered a

major source requiring a Title V permit because emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) are above 100 tons per year. The facility is subject to National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants and must employ Maximum Achievable Control Technology. The facility's potential emissions after controls and limits are given in the table.
