Project Description:

Wastewater Treatment Plant:

Replacement of the influent pump station; a new headworks structure including a mechanical bar screen, manual bypass screen and Parshall flume; modifications to the grit removal system; a new lagoon effluent structure; replacement of two 12-inch valves on the aeration basin influent; new aluminum staircase on aeration basins, and associated electrical upgrades.

Lift Station #2: Rehabilitation of lift station including wetwell coating, electrical system upgrade, and a new emergency generator.

Lift Station #6: Construction of a new wetwell and relocation of the existing pumps and associated piping to the new wetwell.

Lift Station #10: A new emergency generator.

The above named applicant will receive funding assistance from the State Revolving Fund. The North Carolina Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) has conducted a review of the project in accordance with the NCGS §159G-38. The Division has determined that this project is below the minor construction activities threshold outlined in 15A NCAC 01C .0408; therefore, the project is exempt from inter-agency review, and the preparation of additional environmental documents is not required.

This determination shall become effective upon its distribution by the Division and will be available on the Division's website (<http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wi/environmental-documents>). This determination can be revoked at any time adverse information is made available. The documentation to support this decision will be on file with the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Water Infrastructure, and is available for public scrutiny upon request.
