A Draft Post-Closure Permit has been prepared for Clariant East – Mount Holly to conduct post-closure monitoring activities and corrective action at their facility located at 11701 Mount Holly Road in Charlotte, (Mecklenburg County) under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). North Carolina has been authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to administer RCRA including the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984. The State has determined that Clariant East – Mount Holly's proposed activities as identified in the application satisfy the full intent of the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules and Solid Waste Management Act as amended. When finalized this draft permit issued by the State of North Carolina will constitute a complete permit under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

The Clariant East – Mount Holly site is an approximately 370 acre site located in Charlotte, NC and is currently regulated by the NCDEQ - Hazardous Waste Section (HWS) pursuant to a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) post closure and corrective action permit issued on June 23, 2011. The permit is currently in the renewal stage and is needed to continue efforts related to remediating contaminated soil and groundwaters. Historical corrective measures included groundwater recovery and onsite treatment. Future remedial measures will include chemical oxidation which is considered a more aggressive and effective remedial strategy.

The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a forty-five (45) day period to comment on the draft permit. This forty-five (45) day period will commence on January 20, 2023. The draft permit can be found online at the following location: <https://deq.nc.gov/news/events/public-notice-hearings>. A public hearing to receive comments concerning the issuance of the proposed permit will be held on February 24, 2023, at 12pm (Noon), at the Mount Holly Public Library, located at 245 West Catawba Ave., Mount Holly, North Carolina. Attendees may submit a written statement for the official record in addition to their oral statement, or they may submit written comments in lieu of making an oral presentation. When a final permit decision is made to either issue, deny, or modify the permit, notice will be given to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final decision.
