- b) Site map, if the discharge is not directly to a stream, the pathway to the receiving stream must be clearly indicated. This includes tracing the pathway of a storm sewer to its discharge point.
- c) If this application is being submitted by a consulting engineer (*or engineering firm*), include documentation from the applicant showing that the engineer (*or Firm*) submitting the application has been designated an authorized Representative of the applicant, per <u>15A NCAC 02H .0138(b)(1)</u>.
- d) Final plans for the treatment system (*if applicable*). The plans must be signed and sealed by a North Carolina registered Professional Engineer and stamped "Final Design-Not released for construction", per <u>15A NCAC 02H .0139</u>. This includes means for ensuring quality and integrity of the finished product.
