## PUBLIC NOTICE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION OF WATER RESOURCES

The Division of Water Resources (DWR) Director intends to remove the interim maximum allowable concentration (IMAC) in groundwater in accordance with 15A NCAC 02L .0202 for perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) that was established in 2006.

DWR recommends the removal of the 2006 IMAC for PFOA based on more recently published data and anticipated forthcoming regulations from EPA. With the removal of the IMAC, in accordance with 15A NCAC 02L .0202(c), PFOA shall not be permitted in groundwater in concentrations at or above the practical quantitation limit.
