## **RFP Questions and Answers**

**QUESTION:** "In our energy audit there is a recommendation to "Develop HVAC management plan for current operations and identification of preferred technology when units need to be replaced." Since the report has been completed, our City Council approved a sustainable building policy and I have a list of all our HVAC equipment with the projected replacement date. Would this be enough information to qualify to submit an application for new HVAC equipment? The reason I ask is the energy audit's recommendation isn't to purchase new HVAC equipment but rather identify what to replace units with when replacement is necessary. Currently our equipment is 20+ years old so it definitely is due for replacement but I wanted to check that the energy audit provides the necessary information to submit the application for this."

**ANSWER:** Yes, this is enough information to submit an application.

QUESTION: Are local governments receiving a direct EECBG allocation eligible applicants?

**ANSWER:** Yes, they are eligible applicants.
