

DEQ Weatherization Assistance Program

The Weatherization Assistance Program assists families with high energy burdens by providing repairs and upgrades at no cost to eligible residents.

What do home inspections include?



Testing for safety issues like gas leaks and carbon monoxide



Checking combustion appliances like stoves, furnaces, and water heaters



Tuning, repairing or replacing heating equipment



Sealing air infiltration sites and leaky ducts



Adding ventilation and insulation



Installing fire and carbon monoxide detectors



Installing energy efficiency upgrades like energy efficient lights, pipe insulation, low flow shower heads and more



How can the Weatherization Assistance Program help you?

- Tune, repair or replace heating and air systems
- Provide safety and energy efficiency advice
- Make safety and energy efficiency evaluations and upgrades for your home

How do I know if I qualify?

You may qualify if your family:

- Is an owner or renter or;
- Has a gross income at or below 200 percent of the federal poverty guidelines or;
- Receives assistance payments under Work First or Supplemental Security
- Priority is placed on providing assistance to the elderly, individuals with disabilities, families with children, high-energy users, or households with a high energy burden

How do I apply?

You can apply with the designated local service provider for the county in which you live.
