A draft Hazardous Waste Management Permit has been prepared for Venator Chemicals, LLC to conduct post-closure care of three hazardous waste management units, (former lagoons) and site wide remediation activities under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). North Carolina has been authorized by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to administer RCRA including the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) of 1984. The State has determined that Venator Chemicals, LLC's proposed activities as identified in the application satisfy the full intent of the North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules and Solid Waste Management Act as amended. When finalized this draft permit issued by the State of North Carolina will constitute a complete permit under the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

Venator Chemicals, LLC submitted a RCRA Part B Post Closure Permit Application and supporting documents to conduct post-closure care for the closed lagoons and remediation activities for corrective action of contaminated media present at the facility where corrective measures deemed necessary.

The North Carolina Hazardous Waste Management Rules require that the public be given a forty-five (45) day period to comment on the draft permit. This forty-five (45) day period will commence on February 20, 2023. The draft permit can be found online at the following location: <https://deq.nc.gov/news/events/public-notice-hearings>. A public hearing to receive comments concerning the issuance of the proposed permit will be held on Friday, March 31, 2023 at 12:00 p.m., in the auditorium at the Cabarrus County Public Library located at 27 Union Street North, Concord, North Carolina. Attendees may submit a written statement for the official record in addition to their oral statement, or they may submit written comments in lieu of making an oral presentation. When a final permit decision is made to either issue, deny, or modify the permit, notice will be given to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final decision.
