This is the October 2009 update of activities directed by the N.C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources that CTS is performing at the Mills Gap Road site in Asheville.

IHSB-CTS Site, Order of Documents:

October 2009 Update:

- The N.C. Department of Environment and Natural Resources, CTS and MacTec held a conference call to discuss the Phase I Assessment data and plans for the Phase II Assessment Work Plan. There are two small areas on the former CTS plant site that need some additional soil characterization and delineation. These areas include the former sewer line running from the plant to Mills Gap Road and a storage area behind the facility. Additional soil testing in these areas will be included in the overall delineation assessment activities which will be proposed in the upcoming Phase II Assessment Work plan. In the coming weeks, the state Department of Environment and Natural Resources plans to send CTS a formal response to the Phase I Assessment and request that CTS submit the Phase II Work Plan, which is expected shortly thereafter.
- Mr. Aaron Penland mailed a copy of the “CTS Primer,” a DVD produced by several residents involved with the CTS Citizens Action Group, to Mr. John Green, an attorney with the N.C. Department of Justice. Mr. Green mailed the original copy to Bonnie Ware for informational purposes. Ware watched the DVD and mailed the original back to Mr. Green.
