# 1. <u>Request Approval of Proposed Rule Revisions and Regulatory Impact Analysis for 15A</u> NCAC 13B Section .1700 "Requirements for Beneficial Use of Coal Combustion Products" to Proceed to the EMC for Public Comment (DWM) Ed Mussler

**Explanation:** The Division of Waste Management requests approval of proposed rule revisions and regulatory impact analysis for 15A NCAC 13B Section .1700 "Requirements for Beneficial Use of Coal Combustion Products" to proceed to the EMC for public comment. Rules .1701 - .1710 are proposed for readoption as a repeal pursuant to G.S. 150B-21.3A, since new structural fills are required to comply with the Coal Ash Management Act, and Rule .1713 is a new rule proposed for adoption to consolidate requirements from the existing rules that are still necessary for existing structural fills.

**Recommendation:** The Division requests that the GWWMC approve the proposed rule revisions and regulatory impact analysis for 15A NCAC 13B Section .1700 "Requirements for Beneficial Use of Coal Combustion Products" to proceed to the EMC for public comment.

# 2. <u>Request Approval to Proceed to the EMC for Public Notice and Hearings on Amendments to</u> 15A NCAC 02L .0202 Groundwater Quality Standards

- **Explanation:** The Division of Water Resources is requesting approval from the GWWMC to proceed to the EMC to request public notice and hearings on proposed amendments to 15A NCAC 02L .0202 Groundwater Quality Standards. Information has been broken up into 3 parts in order to go over the proposed amendments in more detail. Part 1 and Part 2 were presented at the May 2020 and July 2020 GWWMC meetings, respectively. This presentation will begin by covering Part 3 and conclude with the proposed amendments to 15A NCAC 02L .0202 Groundwater Quality Standards and the recommendation from the Division. Proposed amendments include the incorporation of 44 existing IMACs, some with revisions, into the Groundwater Quality Standards; addition of a Groundwater Quality Standard for three compounds; addition of CAS Register Numbers for existing groundwater standards and proposed incorporated IMACs; and additional updates for clarification.
- **Recommendation:** The Division recommends that the GWWMC approve the proposed amendments to 15A NCAC 02L .0202 Groundwater Quality Standards to proceed to the EMC for public notice and hearings.
