Dear Ms. Bose:

The North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) would like to request a 60-day extension on the due date to file comments on the scoping process to inform the development of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Mountain Valley Pipeline Southgate Project. Notice of the start of the comment period was made on August 15, 2018 by publication in the Federal Register. Twenty-seven days is simply an inadequate period of time for our Agency and other stakeholders to evaluate the Project and provide substantive comments that inform the development and scope of the EIS. Furthermore, as an informal participating agency, the DEQ and other State agencies are presently reviewing the 12 Project Draft Resource Reports, which will significantly contribute to the basis of our EIS comments.

Given the complexity of the Project, taken together with the issues outlined above, we respectfully request that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission extend the period to file comments on the EIS scoping process for an additional 60 days.
