2021 Grant Projects

Shelton Branch Water Quality Feasibility Study (\$27,980)

Southwestern Commission

A feasibility study that identifies streambank restoration and stormwater mitigation needs on private land in the Shelton Branch watershed to complement public projects in addressing fecal and erosion issues.

Designing Water Quality SCMs for Haskett Creek, City of Asheboro (\$25,550)

Piedmont Triad Regional Council

Engineering and design plans for SCMs in two locations identified in the recently approved Haskett Creek Watershed Action Plan to reduce nutrient loads and stormwater volume.

Western North Carolina Stormwater Partnership (\$29,625)

Land of Sky Regional Council

Improved and increased knowledge sharing between the LOSRC member governments to reduce the impacts of stormwater runoff and associated water quality degradation in western NC.

Jordan Lake One Water Facilitation & Pilot Projects (\$44,316)

Triangle J Council of Governments

Professional facilitation of the Jordan Lake One Water process as they move to operationalize recommendations made through past stakeholder processes, seek non-profit certification, and identify areas to launch pilot projects.

Runyon Creek Stormwater Mapping (\$20,000)

Mideast Commission

A stormwater infrastructure map to provide information needed to recommend stormwater improvements and other BMPs to improve water quality. This information will also inform the development of a 9 Element Watershed Plan in Phase II of the project.

Division of Water Resources Stakeholder Meeting Facilitation (\$42,991)

Triangle J Council of Governments

Professional facilitation, meeting logistics, and coordination services for the state's nutrient management strategy efforts, including the Nutrient Scientific Advisory Board, the Nutrient Criteria Development Plan, Science Advisory Committee, and the Criteria Implementation Committee.
