

**Funding Actions Taken at July 10, 2019 Meeting of the State Water Infrastructure Authority on the Applications Submitted in April 2019 to the Division of Water Infrastructure**

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On April 30, 2019, the Division of Water Infrastructure (Division) received applications for funding for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) loan program and the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) loan program. Table 1 shows the amount of funding considered in applications that were complete and eligible, and the approximate amount of funding available.

The State Water Infrastructure Authority (Authority) determined the eligibility of applications selected to receive funding from the available funding sources listed above.
