DEQ Division of Water Resources Development Grant Program Fall 2023 State and Local Grant Awards

RALEIGH - North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality's Water Resources Development Grant Program awarded four State and Local grants in the fall of 2023.

Recipients included:

- 1. The Town of Nags Head received \$101,380 for the Juncos Street Beach Access Improvements project.** This grant will provide financial assistance to replace approximately 2,500 square feet of permeable pavement parking stalls, add a remote pump control system and construct recreational improvements at this beach access.
- 2. The City of Brevard received \$72,000 for the Silversteen Park Norton Creek Upstream Repair project.** This grant will provide financial assistance to restore approximately 70 linear feet of degraded stream and plant 0.1 acres of riparian buffer vegetation.
- 3. The Town of Erwin received \$10,000 for the UT to Juniper Creek at Porter Park Erwin stream restoration project.** This grant will provide financial assistance to restore approximately 900 linear feet of degraded stream.
- 4. Henderson Soil & Water Conservation District received \$66,000 for the Cane Creek Fern Leaf School stream restoration project.** This grant will provide financial assistance to restore approximately 900 linear feet of degraded stream and plant 0.6 acres of riparian buffer vegetation.
