GHG Reporting, Disclosure and Drivers

- CDP (formally Climate Disclosure Project)
 - 18,700 companies disclosing
 - world's leading Env. Report platform)
- Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosure (TCFD)
- International Sustainability Standards Board (ISSB)
- Federal Supplier Climate Disclosure Rule (major fed supplier – to disclose on climate risk
- EU Corporate Sustainability Reporting Directive (CSRD) affects 50,000 large and SME in 1/2023
- EPA Greenhouse Gas Report Program 2010-11
- Securities Exchange Commission (SEC) Draft Rule: Climate-Related Disclosures for Investors

GHG Reduction Goal Setting

Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi)

- Goals in alignment with 1.5 C Climate Limit or well below 2 C limit
- 4,632 companies participating. 2342 with targets, 1706 with net zero commitments
- Companies represent 1/3 of global market capitalization >\$38 trillion
- 4.2% annual emission reductions required to meet 1.5 C limit.
- SBTi approves companies targets and commitments
- SME pathway options
- measurement, reporting and verification (MRV) framework under development.
- Absolute verses intensity-based targets

RE 100 Climate Group

- Large corporation with commitment to utilizing 100% renewable energy (various target years)
- Minimum pathway targets are 60% by 2030, 90% by 2040 & 100% by 2050





DRIVING AMBITIOUS CORPORATE CLIMATE ACTION



GHG Reduction Action Plan

- Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi)
 - 50 carbon reduction by 2030
 - Net Zero emissions by 2050
- Example GHG Goals
- Absolute GHGs Reduction
- 50% (Scope 1-2) by 2030
- 30% (Scope 3) from 2019-2030
- How to cost effectively achieve > 50% reduction in scope 1 & 2 (absolute emissions)?
 - Energy Efficiencies by unit operations
 - On-site renewables & alt fuels utilization
 - Fleet programs
